Throughout camp, you'll work with **our AccuQuilt Cutting Systems, Qube Mix & Match Sets, and Strip Dies**, giving you the opportunity to experience the speed, accuracy, and creativity of die cutting. Bring your favorite holiday scraps, exchange fabrics with fellow quilters, or browse our beautiful selection of fabrics to make your project uniquely yours.

Whether you're new to AccuQuilt or already own a cutting system, you'll leave with knowledge and techniques you can apply to countless future quilting projects—not just this one. Along the way, you'll create a festive Christmas Wreath Block that's perfect for a table topper, wall hanging, quilt, pillow, or a treasured handmade gift for someone special.

 A quick note about irons: Each student is responsible for bringing their own mini iron (120V, low wattage only). We are not able to provide irons in the classroom, but don't worry — ironing mats will be set up and ready for you! Need a mini iron? We carry them right here at the shop

Required Supplies for Class

♦ **Sewing machine - in good working order and ready to sew, Machine Power Cord, Foot Control & Knee Lift (Optional) MUST INSTALL A NEW 75/11 QUILTING NEEDLE BEFORE CLASS**

- The Following Sewing Feet: 1/4" foot, zig zag foot, straight stitch foot
- Rotary Cutter
- 6x24 Ruler, 8 1/2 x 12 ruler, & multi size rulers (Quilters Select Rulers 3x12 ruler, 10 x 10 ruler, 5x5 ruler)
- Mini Iron (120v, low wattage only, available at our shop)
- Straight Pins (for piecing)
- Scissors/Snips
- Quilting Needles 75/11
- Best Press Spray Starch
- Fabric Marking Pens/Pencils
- Neutral thread & wound bobbins for piecing
- Measuring Gauge
- Stiletto

Fabric requirements: Bring your favorite holiday scraps to create a one-of-a-kind wreath, you can share fabrics with fellow classmates, or browse our shop's beautiful selection of fabrics. If you would like the fabrics that are used in the sample, get in touch with Karen to get your choice of fabric set aside for you.

Approx yardage for Scraps (1/4 to 1/2 yd cuts gives you plenty to play with, if repeating fabric on borders & binding bring additional yardage)

Background : 3/4 yd (Fabric used in sample is set aside at the shop for this class white w/small red polkadots)

Green: 1/2 yd

Red: 1/3

Borders : 1/3 to 1/4 yd (this will depend on how many borders you choose)

Binding: 1/3 to 1/4 yd (this will depend on your finished block size)
