# Required Supplies for Class

## Session 1 Cutting and prep work only

Party Pack or 12 fat quarters

1 yard background fabric

1 yard inner boarder fabric

1 yard outer boarder fabric

Rotary cutter

Best press starch

Rulers: 6 x 24, 8 1/2 square or larger square ruler

## Session 2 Piecing (sewing)

Sewing Machine in working order, power cord, foot control, 1/4" foot, straight stitch foot

Quilting needles (75/11)

Neutral thread for piecing

Fully wound bobbins ready for piecing

Mini Wand Iron (120V) available at our shop

Scissors & snips

Rotary cutter

Seam ripper

Pins

Rulers: 6 x 24, 8 1/2 square or larger square ruler

Stiletto

Best press starch

Measuring gauge

Fabric marking pens/pencils
