◆ **Sewing machine - in good working order and ready to sew, Machine Power Cord, Foot Control & Knee Lift (Optional) MUST INSTALL A NEW QUILTING NEEDLE BEFORE CLASS**

◆ **The Following Sewing Feet: Walking Foot with straight stitch foot & seam bar guide, 1/4" foot, zig zag foot, straight stitch foot**

5. 6x24 Ruler and smaller rulers (3 x 12) something rectangle shaped

15. 4 Wound Bobbins (2 neutral colors for piecing & 2 Isacord contrasting colors)

16. Note pad & pen for notes, fine point permeant marker

17. Measuring Gauge

18. Stiletto

19. Best Press Spray Starch
