

Sewing Machine with power cord & foot pedal *in good working order - cleaned & ready*

Install new needle 90/14

- Walking foot & feet, seam bar guide, & regular sewing feet.
- Bring extra needles 90/14
- Bright pink Isacord thread w/ a wound bobbin
- Small Scissors for cutting threads
- Medium to large scissors for cutting fabric
- Rotary cutter
- Seam ripper
- Ruler: 2 1/2 inch by 12 inch ruler or bigger, almost any ruler will be fine
- Pins
- Fabric clips
- Measuring guide
- Permanent fine point marking pen
- Air Erase or Water Soluble fabric marking pen
- Pen and paper for note taking
