Supply List

Day 1: Do not bring your machine

Tee pattern-RSC

Pattern paper 1.333 yd

3 pencils sharpened

Paper scissors

Tape measure

Pattern Weights optional

Waffle knit fabric-RSC or own knit fabric washed, see pattern size for yardage

Small quilt ruler min 3"x 12"

Day 2 see below:

Days Two and Three

Machine with power and foot pedal (Sergers/coverstitch)

In good working order

Traced pattern pieces

Original Pattern

Fabric-washed

3 cones of matching serger thread

Overlock needles 80/12 light knits, waffle knit 90/14-RSC needles that come with machine should work

Fabric scissors

Tape measure

Rotary cutter-optional/Ruler

Pins - must have

Pattern weights-optional

Clips-optional

Washaway Wonder Tape

Chalk marker- RSC

Fabric Glue Pen

Stiletto
