

Festival of Light Table Runner *Finished size 12 inches x 41 ½ inches*

Set a festival table this Hanukkah with this Festival of Lights pattern. In this one-day class, you will learn Foundation paper piecing techniques which are used for the candles and Star of David Blocks.

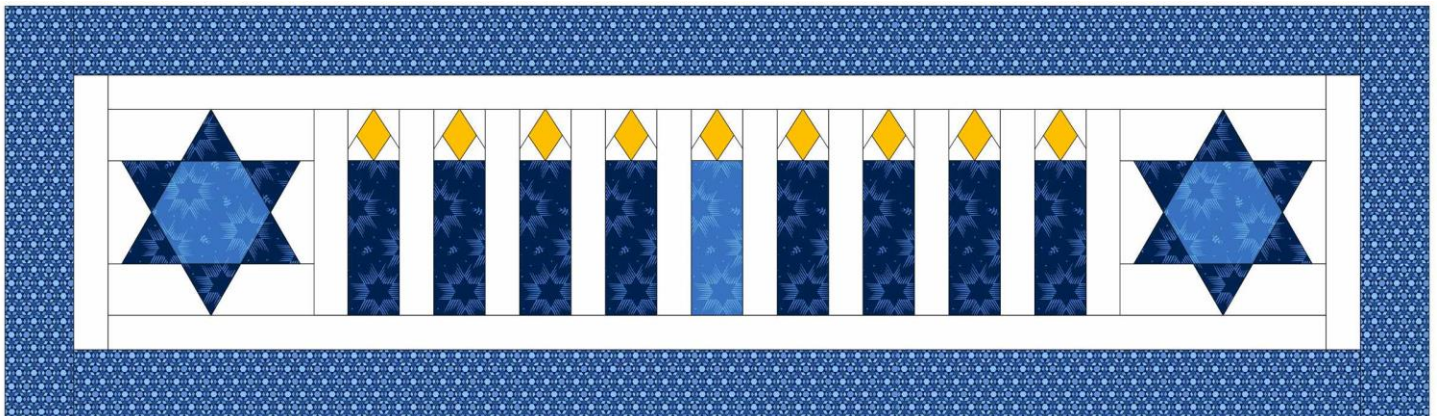
This table runner is adapted from the Festival of Lights Quilt Pattern by Karen Kehl being published in the November/December Quiltmaker Magazine.

Material List

- Copy of Festival of Lights quilt pattern from November/December 2022 Quiltmaker magazine - You will need two printed paper copies of the Star of David block (6 1/2") and 9 printed copies of the candle block (6 1/2" size) from the November/December 2022 Quiltmaker Festival of Light Pattern for paper piecing.
- Working sewing machine with cord – Machine needs to sew a straight stitch.
- Rotary cutter
- Small cutting mat
- 6" x 12" or 6" x 24" inch ruler for rotary cutting
- "Add a quarter" ruler or small (1" x 6") clear ruler with quarter inch markings
- Thread – white or light gray
- Pins
- Seam ripper
- (Optional) Iron and ironing pad or seam pressing tool

Fabric needed:

- A) 1/2 yard - White or light for background
- B) 1/4 yard – Dark blue for candles and star points
- C) 1/8 yard – Medium blue for central candle and center of stars
- D) 1/8 yard – Gold for candle flames
- E) 3/8 yard – Blue print for border



Materials needed to complete table runner, but will not be used in class

- 1/2 yard for backing
- 1/2 yard 40 inch wide batting
- 1/4 yard for binding
