# Origami Bags

#### Fabric Requirements:

For One Bag:

Fabric A: Fat Quarter.
Fabric B: Fat Quarter.

Ribbon or cording: 1-1/2" yd.

# **Cutting** •

Fabric A: Cut One 17-1/2" Square for Larger size or 14-1/2" Square for Smaller size.

Fabric B: Cut One 17-1/2" Square for Larger size or 14-1/2" Square for Smaller size.

# **Assembly**

- 1. Layer fabric A and fabric B, right sides together and round two opposite corners using a Corner rounding template or plate with an 8" diameter. Sew around all sides including the rounded corners, turn right side out and press. Topstitch around the sewn edges.
- **2.** Fold over the two corners so they overlap (how much overlap determines the width and height of your bag). Stitch across the folds, two seams, 1" from the center as shown.
- **3.** Fold the bag in half, right sides together, aligning the rounded edges. Sew up the two sides with about an 1/8" seam. Box the corners. Turn the bag right side out.
- **4.** Fold the rounded edges down and stitch a casing, about 1" on each side.
- **5.**Thread two pieces of ribbon, about 24" long, through the casings from opposite sides and tie together on each side.
