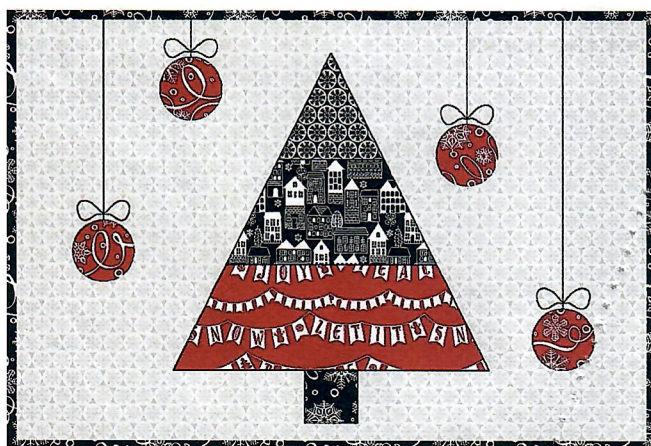
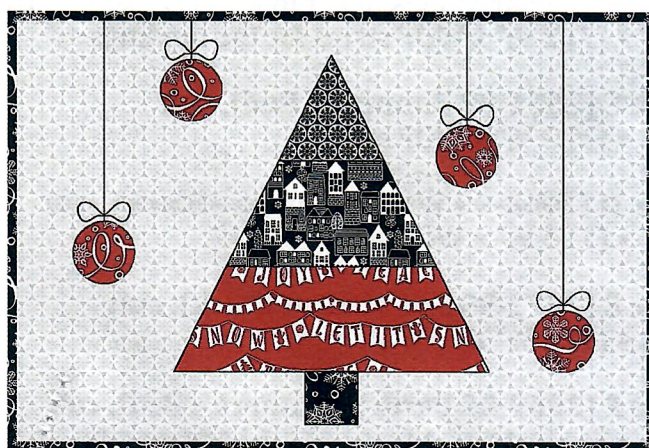
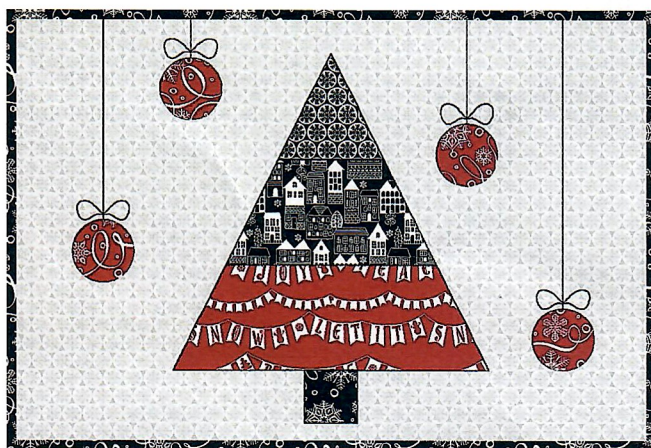

Fabric Requirements (set of 4 place mats)

(A) 2973-09	7/8 yard	Backing	
(B) 2969-99	2/3 yard*	2972-09	1 yard
(C) 2971-88	1/8 yard	*includes binding	
(D) 2968-99	1/8 yard		
(E) 2973-99	1/8 yard		
(F) 2969-88	1/8 yard		

Additional Supplies Needed

Batting (4) 15" x 21" pieces
Piecing and sewing thread
Quilting and sewing supplies
Triangle template
Fusible web

Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (2973-09 Snowballs – Gray), cut:

- (2) 12 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 12 ½" x 18 ½" strips

Fabric B (2968-99 Party Streamers – Black), cut:

- See instructions to cut four 1-1/2" square tree trunks
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the bindings

Fabric C (2971-88 Banners – Red), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip

Fabric D (2968-99 Winter Village – Black), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip

Fabric E (2973-99 Snowballs – Black), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip

Fabric F (2969-88 Party Streamers – Red), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) ornaments

Backing (2972-09 Damask – Gray), cut:

- (2) 15" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 15" x 21" strips for the backs

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strip, (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strip and (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip together, lengthwise and in that order, to make (1) CDE strip (Fig. 1).

2. Place fusible web on the wrong side of the CDE strip.
3. Enlarge triangle template 200%. Using the triangle template, cut out (4) trees (Fig. 2).

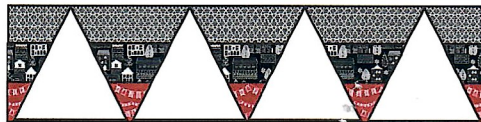

4. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the drawn lines.
5. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
6. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (1) tree, (1) trunk and (4) ornaments onto the (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A piece (Fig. 3). Repeat to make four Place Mats total.

7. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the place mats.

8. Hand or machine stitch the ornament strings and bows.

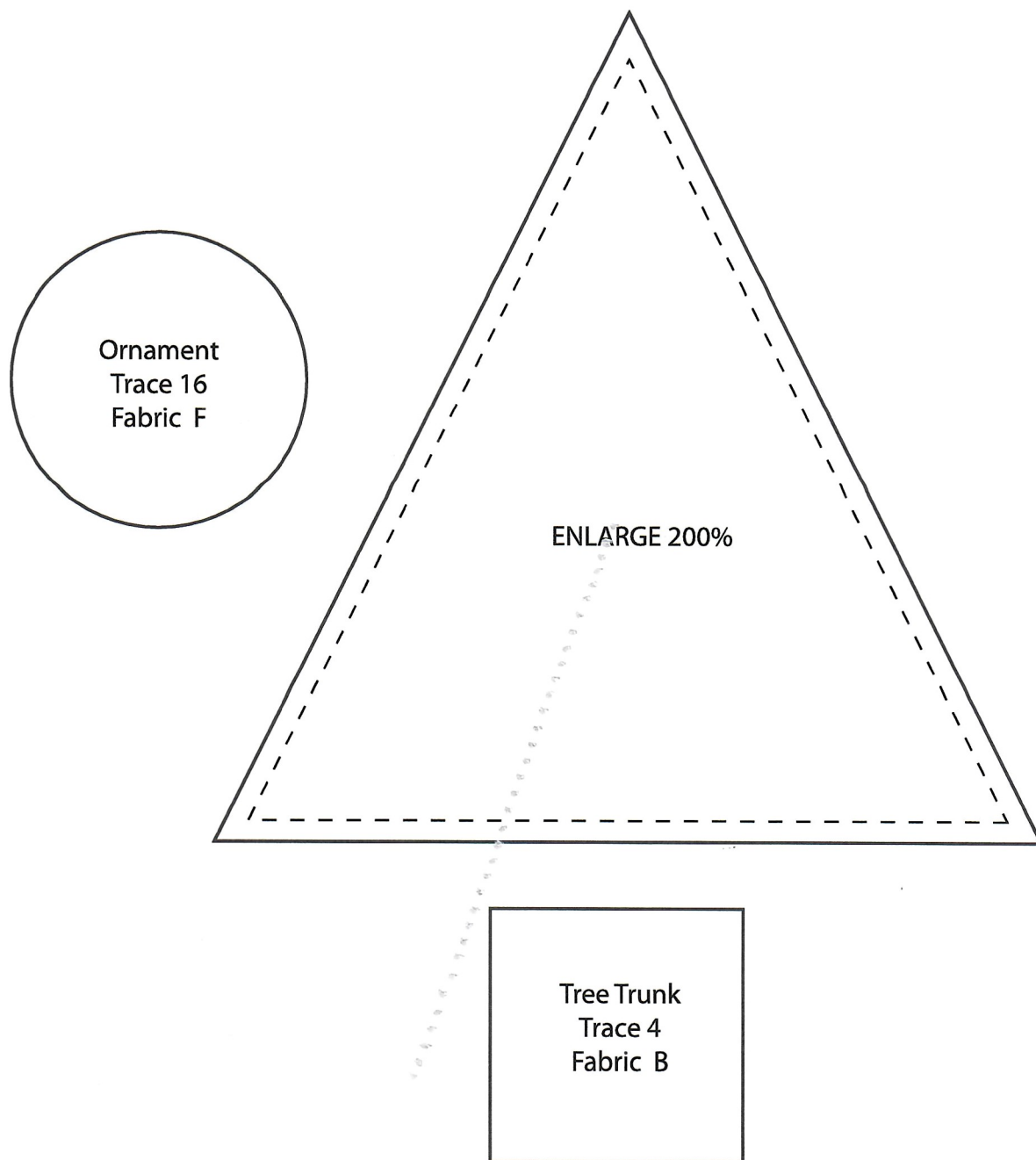
Layering, Quilting and Finishing

9. Press the place mats and 15" x 21" backings well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed place mat (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

10. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric B binding strips at 45-degree angles and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together. Divide the strip into (4) equal parts.

11. Sew the binding to the front of the place mats, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
