


## Second Saturday Club 2021 via Zoom

### Tula Pink's City Sampler

For 2021, the Second Saturday Club will work through *Tula Pink's City Sampler: 100 Modern Quilt Blocks*. The book provides instructions for blocks with a finished size of 6 inches, plus 5 layouts of different size quilts and useful commentary on color, techniques, and tools.

Each month, group members will create blocks from a section of the book, and later in the year they will assemble them in the quilt design of their choice. Every quilt will be a unique representation of each quilter's individual vision. Along the way, we'll talk about color, piecing techniques, shortcuts, and arranging completed blocks in a satisfying pattern.

The City Sampler blocks are approachable for beginning quilters, while intermediate and advanced quilters will enjoy playing with color and trying the Design-Your-Own-Block challenge. City Sampler quilts look great in Tula Pink's fabrics, of course, but work well with many other options: solids, batiks, blenders, monochromatic, scrappy.

**Skill level:** Confident beginner and up

**Class format:** The Second Saturday Club meets on the second Saturday of every month; in 2021, the club will meet via Zoom. Meetings include a review of the previous month's blocks; discussion of the current month's blocks; a skills session; and show-and-tell so members can show off their finished projects.

### Technology

**Zoom:** Download the Zoom app/client: <https://zoom.us/client/latest/ZoomInstaller.exe>. You will need a laptop or tablet with a camera/webcam, microphone, and speakers, plus an Internet connection. On the day before each meeting, you will receive an email with a link to the meeting. Click on the link and connect both computer audio and video.

Each session will be recorded and made available for a limited time for club members to download.

**Photos:** In order to share your blocks-in-progress and your show-and-tell projects, you'll need to be able to take and email digital (cell phone) photos of your work on a design wall.

## **Supplies**

**Required for the first session:** *Tula Pink's City Sampler: 100 Modern Quilt Blocks*

**Fabric:** At the first session in January, we'll talk about color choices and quilt designs, so we recommend that you wait to purchase fabric until then. In general, though, the amount of fabric you buy will depend on how many blocks you plan to make and how you assemble them with sashing. To make a throw or twin quilt, you will probably need 15-20 assorted fat quarters for the blocks, plus additional fabric for sashing, backing, and binding.

**For the January meeting:** We suggest you become familiar with the book, especially the Introduction (p. 7), choosing colors (p. 224-225), tools (p. 226), and the various quilt layouts (pp. 228-251). If you'd like to audition fabrics from your stash, go ahead and pull them.

## **Capital Quilts Policies for All Classes**

Please do not bring visitors to class.

Be sure to check your supply list before class. Bring all supplies with you.

If you must cancel the class, your fee can be refunded ONLY if you have notified us at least seven days before the class. The refund will be a store credit. If someone on the waiting list can fill your place, you will receive store credit for the fee, even if you have not notified us by the deadline.

Capital Quilts reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient participation. We require at least two people in a daytime class and three in an evening class. If we cancel the class for this reason, you will receive a full refund of the class fee. (You can avoid this situation by getting a friend to sign up with you!)

If Capital Quilts cancels the class for any reason, including inclement weather, you will receive an email advising you of this situation. If the class is rescheduled, you will be invited to come to the new class before the class is opened to public registration. In the event you cannot take the rescheduled class, you will receive a full refund of the class fee.
