

Supply List for Lemoyne Star Sampler Instructor: Pat Vasaio

BOOK (Required): Lemoyne Stars Made Easy by Sharyn Squier Craig (This book is out of print, but available on Amazon.com)

TOOL (Required): Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Ruler by Deb Tucker (Studio 180)

FABRIC: The yardage includes approximately ¼ yard extra for mistakes.

- Background for stars 3 yards
- Star points at least three fabrics 1 yard each, or scraps totaling 3 yards. In the shop model I used 12 fat quarters to give more variety.

Please bring all the above fabric to class.

Setting: While the setting is up to you, if you wish to set your blocks like the shop model, you will need the following:

• Block surrounds and corner stones: 1-1/4 yards

Setting triangles: 1-1/4 yards

• Sashing: 1-1/2 yards

• Border: cut lengthwise: 2-3/8 yards

Binding: 2/3 yards

OTHER NECESSITIES:

- Sewing machine with 1/4" foot and new needle
- Neutral piecing thread
- Cutting mat and rotary cutter with new blade
- 6" x 12" ruler or 12.5" square
- Usual sewing supplies, scissors, marking pencil, pins, and your seam ripper

Recommended:

• Mary Ellen's Best Press. (I found that using Best Press helped stabilize the fabric as I was cutting the bias pieces. Use Best Press before cutting strips.)

Cutting instructions for Class 1:

For the first class: Please bring 2 strips of background fabric 3-1/4" by WOF.

Bring 1 strip of two different star point fabrics 2" by WOF.

If you are using fat quarters for your star points, then pleases cut 2 strips of each fabric. Cut each strip from selvage to raw edge so the strips measure about 22" in length.

If you have never used the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool, you might want to consider bringing scrap fabric to the first class to practice the technique before using your good fabric.
