



## Supply List for Capital Quilts' Complete Course of Quilting

### Book (REQUIRED):

- All Things Quilting by Alex Anderson

### Fabric:

- 2 or more yards of Border or "theme" fabric
  - This fabric will be used in the border and some of your blocks.
- 5-8 Fat Quarters of coordinating fabrics
  - Select a variety of lights, mediums, and darks in small, medium, and large scale prints. Tone on tone, florals, geometrics – even stripes and plaids will work.

*Wash and press all of your fabric prior to the first class.*

### Other Supplies:

- Your sewing machine, **in good working order**, with power cord, foot pedal, all feet, and the manual.
  - NOTE: Sewing machines need to be serviced annually. If your machine needs to be serviced prior to class, please allow 2 weeks. Capital Quilts is able to perform general maintenance on all brands of machines.
- ¼" foot for sewing machine (does not usually come with machines; generics are available at Capital Quilts)
- Walking foot for sewing machine (generics are available at Capital Quilts)
- Schmetz brand sewing machine needles, size 80/12 or 70/10, Microtex or Sharp
- Neutral thread (light tan or light grey), 100% cotton (Aurifil or Presencia)
  - Fill a bobbin with your thread before class
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Silk straight pins
- Tailor's awl
- Rotary cutting mat, at least 18" x 24"
- Rotary cutter, 45mm or larger, with a new blade installed
- Rotary cutting rulers:
  - 6" x 24" or 6 ½" x 24"
  - Square ruler, at least 9 ½"
- Paper and pen or pencil for taking notes
- Binder or folder for handouts

Additional supplies will be needed throughout the course. Your instructor will advise you on these.

### CLASS POLICIES:

Sewing Machine:

- You must use your own sewing machine in this class.
- Rentals of shop machines is not permitted in this class.
- Your machine should be serviced (in the past year) before class.
- **You do not need to bring your sewing machine to the first class.**
