

Supply List for Labyrinth Instructor: Jackie Kelso

Pattern (Required): "Labyrinth" by Judy and Judel Niemeyer, available at Capital Quilts

Fabric:

- Thirty-six 10" squares
- 1-1/2 yard center diagonal accent fabric
- 1-7/8 yard barrow diagonal accent strips
- 1-5/8 yard border 1 and binding fabric
- 1-7/8 yard border 2 fabric

OTHER NECESSITIES: Please make sure you bring the following items to class. They are essential to the techniques I teach:

- Charm Elements 19 Foundation papers, available at Capital Quilts
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot, a quarter-inch foot, and accessories
- Steam iron (provided by Capital Quilts, but feel free to bring your own small iron, portable ironing mat, and an extension cord)
- One piece of Template Plastic (3" by 12" piece)
- 12" Add-a-quarter ruler
- Purple Thang (optional)
- 6" by 12" ruler
- Medium size cutting mat (18" by 24")
- Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm, with a new blade installed
- Size 70 needles (Microtex Sharp recommended)
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Fabric glue stick
- Glue Pen
- High quality cotton sewing thread
- Flower pins (Optional)
- Best Press Spray
- Scotch Tape
- Large Ziploc Bags
- Stapler
- Binder Clips
