



Supply List for Looking Glass  
Instructor: Jennifer McClanahan

### Pattern (required):

- Looking Glass by Jennifer McClanahan, Sweet Tea Pattern Co., available at Capital Quilts

### Fabric: the following is based on a 70" x 70" finished quilt.

- Main (pinwheels and white squares): 14 different fat quarters or ¼ yards
- Accent (grid): 1½ yards
- Background: 3 yards
- Binding: 1 yard
- Backing: 4-3/8 yards
- Batting: 80" x 80"

### Other Necessities:

- Sewing machine in good working order, with the power cord and foot pedal and a new needle.
- Thread for piecing
- Basic sewing supplies: pins, snips, seam ripper
- Rulers: 15½" square and 12" long straight
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Marking pen or pencil (Jennifer likes the Frixion Pens)
- Optional but highly recommended: Mary Ellen's Best Press Clear Starch for pressing your fabrics
- Optional: Quilter's Magic Wand (you'll be making half square triangles)
- Optional: Strip Stick to make ironing the seams open a lot easier

### CLASS POLICIES:

- Please do not bring visitors to class.
- Be sure to check your supply list before class. Bring all supplies with you.
- If you must cancel the class, your fee can be refunded ONLY if you have notified us at least seven days before the class. The refund will be a store credit. If someone on the waiting list can fill your place, you will receive store credit for the fee, even if you have not notified us by the deadline.
- Capital Quilts reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient participation. We require at least two people in a daytime class and three in an evening class. If we cancel the class for this reason, you will receive a full refund of the class fee. (You can avoid this situation by getting a friend to sign up with you!)
- If Capital Quilts cancels the class for any reason, including inclement weather, you will receive an email advising you of this situation. We also post store closings on our website, [www.capitalquilts.com](http://www.capitalquilts.com), and on Facebook. If the class is rescheduled, you will be invited to come to the new class before the class is opened to public registration. In the event you cannot take the rescheduled class, you will receive a full refund of the class fee.

Classroom sewing machines are available for rental during a class. There is a \$10 fee per class session. Quantities are limited, so please ask to reserve a machine as soon as possible. Plan to come to the shop early on the day of class so that we can show you how to thread and operate the machine.

**BEFORE COMING TO CLASS:** If you do as much cutting at home as you can, you'll be able to spend your time in class sewing.

- Main Fabric (the pinwheels and white squares): cut (25) 4½" square pieces and (52) 5" square pieces out of an assortment of the fat quarters. Refer to the picture on the front of the pattern.
- Accent Fabric (the black grid): cut (25) strips 1½" x WOF. Cut these strips into (150) 4½"-long pieces and (50) 6½"-long pieces.
- Background Fabric (gray solid on the pattern cover): cut (12) strips 4½" x WOF; from these cut (48) 9½" -long pieces. Cut (7) strips, 5" x WOF; from these, cut (52) 5" squares. Cut (6) strips 1½" x WOF; from these, cut (52) 4½"-long pieces.
