



Supply List for *Mini Mosaics*

Pattern: Please choose one of the following Cheryl Lynch Mini Mosaic patterns or kits, available at Capital Quilts (others are available for special ordering).

- Sea Turtle
- Tiny Town
- Flamingo
- Lighthouse
- Bird
- Giraffe
- Flower

Fabric:

If you have NOT purchased a kit, check the back of your chosen pattern for specific scrap color requirements.

- You will need an assortment of 2" batik squares in the colors indicated on the pattern.
- 11" x 14" cream fabric for "grout"
- Two 1" x WOF strips for inner border
- Two 1 1/2" x WOF strips for outer border
- Two 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding
- Fat Quarter for backing

Other Supplies:

- Mini Mosaic Cutting Tool – available at Capital Quilts
- Tweezers
- Rotary cutter & cutting mat
- Small, sharp scissors – micro-serrated blades recommended
- Two thicknesses of foam core board or three thicknesses of corrugated cardboard, taped together and measuring 14" x 17"
- Masking tape
- Thumb tacks
- Sewing machine with foot pedal and cords (not needed in first session)
- Thread – 50wt neutral for attaching borders, and heavier cream or off-white for quilting
- Reading glasses - optional
