

Supply List for Running With Scissors Instructor: Kathleen Barden

To make the most of class time, you must come prepared. Allow yourself a minimum of 4 hours to complete the following pre-class requirements. The class will begin on page 2 at *Step II. Preparing Components*.

Read through the Running With Scissors pattern pages 1 and 2. Complete *Step 1. A through C* on page 2. This includes quilting and cutting your main fabric and lining fabrics with the Soft and Stable; as well as cutting coordinating fabrics, interfacings, mesh fabric, vinyl, strapping and fold over elastic.

Label, **label** every piece you cut using the label page provided in the pattern.

If you have more questions about the class preparation, or are uncomfortable doing it on your own, we are offering an optional Introductory Class. See class calendar at www.capitalquilts.com for date (usually within a week of class).

Pattern (REQUIRED):

Fabric: avoid directional fabrics

Body of case, pockets: ¾ yard

• Borders and center facing: 1 fat quarter (18" x 22" approx.)

Lining, pockets: ¾ yard

• Bindings, straps, handle, zipper pulls: 34 yard

Inner pockets: mesh 4" x 13½"
Inner pockets: vinyl 12" x 12½"

CLASS POLICIES:

- Please do not bring visitors to class.
- Be sure to check your supply list before class. Bring all supplies with you.
- If you must cancel the class, your fee can be refunded ONLY if you have notified us at least seven days before the class. The refund will be a store credit. If someone on the waiting list can fill your place, you will receive store credit for the fee, even if you have not notified us by the deadline.
- Capital Quilts reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient participation. We require at least two people in a daytime class and three in an evening class. If we cancel the class for this reason, you will receive a full refund of the class fee. (You can avoid this situation by getting a friend to sign up with you!)
- If Capital Quilts cancels the class for any reason, including inclement weather, you will receive an email advising you of this situation. We also post store closings on our website, www.capitalquilts.com, and on Facebook. If the class is rescheduled, you will be invited to come to the new class before the class is opened to public registration. In the event you cannot take the rescheduled class, you will receive a full refund of the class fee.

Classroom sewing machines are available for rental during a class. There is a \$10 fee per class session. Quantities are limited, so please ask to reserve a machine as soon as possible. Plan to come to the shop early on the day of class so that we can show you how to thread and operate the machine.

Notions:

- Soft and Stable stabilizer: 36" x 58"
- Fusible interfacing: 7" x 121/2"
- Handbag zippers: two 30" or longer double-slide zippers and one 40" or longer double-slide zipper
- Polypro Strapping, 1": ¾ yard
- Fold-over elastic, 20mm: ¾ yard
- Thread to blend with your fabric choices

OTHER NECESSITIES:

- Sewing machine, in good working order, with foot pedal and power cord
- Machine needles: sizes 16 and 20 or denim
- Rotary cutter (new blade installed) and mat
- Quilter's ruler, 6" x 24
- Straight pins
- Wonder clips
- Seam ripper
- Scissors
- Stiletto
- Marking pen or pencil
- Quilter's Choice Basting Glue (optional)
