



Supply List for **Scrappy Color Wheel Quilt** Instructor: **Karen Fricke**

Fabrics used in the color wheel should be primarily "true hue." That means they are very close to the actual color, not a paler, grayer, or darker version of that color. We will be using all primary, secondary, and tertiary colors in the color wheel on the next page. Lay the scraps of one color on a white background, then stand back and squint at the assortment. If one of them looks out of place, it probably is. If you're not sure, bring it to class.

Fabric:

- 10 to 12 scraps of fabric, each about 4" x 4", for EACH of the twelve colors in the color wheel
- 4 neutral fat quarters for background. I used four gray prints, but black and white prints would work, as would ecru.*
- Neutral 5" x 5" scraps and/or fat quarters or eighths for the border. You will need a total of approximately ½ yard.*
- ½ yard for binding
- 1 yard for backing and at least 36" square piece of batting ("craft" size)

Supplies:

- neutral thread for piecing
- Sewing machine with piecing or straight stitch foot
- Scissors, rotary cutter, rotary ruler, rotary mat
- Pins, hand sewing needle, preferred marking tool

* For an easier version, use 1-½ yards of a single solid neutral fabric (or a fabric that "reads" as a solid) for all the background of the color wheel and the border.
