



Supply List for Showering Stars Table Runner Instructor: Cathy Sullivan

PATTERN (Required): "Showering Stars" by Robin Pickens, available at Capital Quilts

FABRIC

Refer to the picture on the front of the pattern.

- Patchwork Blocks: 1/8 yd. (or a 2½" x WOF strip) of 6 assorted fabrics. Select at least one light fabric. One could be a medium/dark narrow striped fabric. You can also use lots of different 2" x 2" scraps. Small prints, narrow stripes, and blenders work well.
- Star Points: ½ yd. (white in picture). Must have good contrast with background.
- Background: 1 yd. (red in picture)
- Backing: 1 yd.; if planning to quilt your runner on a longarm, get an extra 1/3 yd.
- Binding: ½ yd.
- Batting: 22" wide by 2¼ yd. long

OTHER NECESSITIES

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord and foot pedal
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Ruler: 6" x 24"
- Thread for piecing
- Basic sewing supplies: straight pins, marking pen or pencil, scissors and/or snips, seam ripper

Optional: small iron and ironing mat

BEFORE CLASS CUTTING

HOMEWORK: Please do the following cutting BEFORE coming to class so that you can spend class time sewing.

From the assorted scrap or 1/8 yd. pieces of fabric, cut:

(48) 2" x 2" squares

(4) 9½" x 2" rectangles – consider using the narrowly striped fabric for these

CLASS POLICIES:

- Please do not bring visitors to class.
- Be sure to check your supply list before class. Bring all supplies with you. Please label all supplies with your name.
- If you must cancel the class, your fee can be refunded ONLY if you have notified us at least seven days before the class. The refund will be a store credit. If someone on the waiting list can fill your place, you will receive store credit for the fee, even if you have not notified us by the deadline.
- Capital Quilts reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient participation. We require at least two people in a daytime class and three in an evening class. If we cancel the class for this reason, you will receive a full refund of the class fee. (You can avoid this situation by getting a friend to sign up with you!)
- If Capital Quilts cancels the class for any reason, including inclement weather, you will receive an email advising you of this situation. We also post store closings on our website, www.capitalquilts.com, and on Facebook. If the class is rescheduled, you will be invited to come to the new class before the class is opened to public registration. In the event you cannot take the rescheduled class, you will receive a full refund of the class fee.

Classroom sewing machines are available for rental during a class. There is a \$10 fee per class session. Quantities are limited, so please ask to reserve a machine as soon as possible. Plan to come to the shop early on the day of class so that we can show you how to thread and operate the machine.

From the 1/2 yd. for the star points (white), cut:

(16) 3-1/8" x 3-1/8" squares

draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each of the above squares

(28) 2" x 2" squares

From the Background (red) fabric, cut:

(2) 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" squares

(2) 9 1/2" x 5 3/4" rectangles

(2) 9 1/2" x 4 1/4" rectangles

(4) 5 3/4" x 5 3/4" squares

(16) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" squares

(2) 2 3/4" x 17" rectangles

(2) 2" x 17" rectangles

(4) 2" x 9 1/2" rectangles

(20) 2" x 4 1/4" rectangles

(2) 2" x 5 3/4" rectangles

(1) 2" x 2 3/4" rectangle

(4) 2" x 2" squares
