



Supply List for **Simply a Pleasure** Table Runner Instructor: **Cathy Sullivan**

This table runner is very attractive and actually very easy - so it matches its name - **SIMPLY A PLEASURE** to make! We will make the runner in class, but the pattern also has instructions for 4 placemats. If you want to make those as well, the fabric requirements for both the runner and placemats are listed below. **PRECUTTING** is optional - if you precut at home, you will be able to finish the runner in class and may be able to start a second runner or get a few placemats done. If you don't have time to precut, you can cut the materials in class and you can probably finish the runner in class! This pattern makes a runner that can be elegant or whimsical depending on your choice of fabric - a great gift or a nice addition to your own home!

Pattern (Required):

- **Simply a Pleasure**, by Nicole Chambers-Kaya, available at Capital Quilts

Fabric for runner:

- focus fabric (could be a floral or large print) - one fat quarter - make sure you can get 3 subcuts with a design that you like that each measure 7 1/4" square ; if not, buy slightly more fabric
- a light coordinating fabric - 1/4 yard
- a dark coordinating fabric - 3/4 yard (includes binding)
- backing - 1 yard
- batting - 16" x 48"

PRE-CLASS Cutting:

- focus fabric
 - cut three 7 1/4" squares (make sure you like the design for each square before you cut)
- light fabric
 - cut two WOF strips each 2 3/4"; leave one whole and subcut the other one into 8 rectangles 5" x 2 3/4"
- dark fabric
 - cut one 2 3/4" strip; subcut two 5" x 2 3/4" rectangles and bring the remaining 30" to class
- cut one 7 3/4" strip; subcut into three 7 3/4" rectangles
- cut three strips 2 1/4" wide for binding

CLASS POLICIES:

- Please do not bring visitors to class.
- Be sure to check your supply list before class. Bring all supplies with you. Please label all supplies with your name.
- If you must cancel the class, your fee can be refunded **ONLY** if you have notified us at least seven days before the class. The refund will be a store credit. If someone on the waiting list can fill your place, you will receive store credit for the fee, even if you have not notified us by the deadline.
- Capital Quilts reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient participation. We require at least two people in a daytime class and three in an evening class. If we cancel the class for this reason, you will receive a full refund of the class fee. (You can avoid this situation by getting a friend to sign up with you!)
- If Capital Quilts cancels the class for any reason, including inclement weather, you will receive an email advising you of this situation. We also post store closings on our website, www.capitalquilts.com, and on Facebook. If the class is rescheduled, you will be invited to come to the new class before the class is opened to public registration. In the event you cannot take the rescheduled class, you will receive a full refund of the class fee.

Classroom sewing machines are available for rental during a class. There is a \$10 fee per class session. Quantities are limited, so please ask to reserve a machine as soon as possible. Plan to come to the shop early on the day of class so that we can show you how to thread and operate the machine.

Fabric for placemats:

- focus fabric - one fat quarter - make sure you can get 4 subcuts with a design that you like that each measure 7 1/4" square
- a light coordinating fabric - 1/2 yard
- a dark coordinating fabric - 1 yard (includes binding)
- backing - 1 1/2 yard
- batting - four pieces EACH 16" x 27"

Other Necessities:

- Sewing machine, in good working order, with foot pedal and power cord
- Rotary Cutter, with new blade, and mat
- Thread to match fabric
- Straight pins, seam ripper, snips for cutting thread, fabric marker
- 6" x 24" clear acrylic ruler
