



Supply List for Sprinkles Instructor: Kim Jalette

Pattern:

"Sprinkles" by Julie Herman, Jaybird Quilts (Required), and available at Capital Quilts

Fabric:

This is a Baby size quilt, fabric requirements are listed below.

	<u>Baby 37" x 44"</u>
Feature fabric strips	(13) assorted 2 1/2" x 40"
Background	1 3/8 yds (if scrappy, fabrics to total this yardage)
Binding	3/8 yd
Backing	1 1/2 yds
Batting	42" x 48"

Other Supplies:

- Sidekick ruler by Jaybird Quilts, available at Capital Quilts (Can also use Super Sidekick)
- Sewing machine (put in a new needle if you haven't lately!)
- Rotary cutting tools: rotary cutter (new blade, lots of cutting!), mat, 6 x 24 or similar ruler for strip cutting
- Neutral piecing thread (I love Aurifil)
- Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper)

I also recommend having:

- Mary Ellen's Best Press – apply to fabric before cutting strips
- Strip Stick – for pressing seams open (believe me, you will love this!)
- TruGrips gripper circles or Grip Strips – for the back of your ruler
- Wonder Clips – to use when binding your quilt

CLASS POLICIES:

- Please do not bring visitors to class.
- Be sure to check your supply list before class. Bring all supplies with you.
- If you must cancel the class, your fee can be refunded ONLY if you have notified us at least seven days before the class. The refund will be a store credit. If someone on the waiting list can fill your place, you will receive store credit for the fee, even if you have not notified us by the deadline.
- Capital Quilts reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient participation. We require at least two people in a daytime class and three in an evening class. If we cancel the class for this reason, you will receive a full refund of the class fee. (You can avoid this situation by getting a friend to sign up with you!)
- If Capital Quilts cancels the class for any reason, including inclement weather, you will receive an email advising you of this situation. We also post store closings on our website, www.capitalquilts.com, and on Facebook. If the class is rescheduled, you will be invited to come to the new class before the class is opened to public registration. In the event you cannot take the rescheduled class, you will receive a full refund of the class fee.

Classroom sewing machines are available for rental during a class. There is a \$10 fee per class session. Quantities are limited, so please ask to reserve a machine as soon as possible. Plan to come to the shop early on the day of class so that we can show you how to thread and operate the machine.

Pre-class prep:

I strongly recommend using Mary Ellen's Best Press when pressing your fabric before cutting any strips. This gives you extra stability in cutting, sewing and pressing units.

Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips from background fabric before class.

Bring all strips and remaining background fabric to class. You will not need the binding, backing and batting before class.
