



DECORATIVE SERGER TECHNIQUES



You will create samples of a variety of serger techniques- some practical, others decorative. Class will be held in a "round robin format". A variety of machines will be set up for particular techniques. You will simply move from one machine to the next and make a sample for yourself. Header cards will be attached to each sample with technique description and how to set up your machine to duplicate.Note:Some techniques require features your machine might not be capable of.
