BEGINNING SEWING (3 sessions)

Get to know your machine. We work with you to use and understand the operation of your machine. ADVANCED BEGINNING QUILTING (6 sessions)

ROTARY CUTTING BASICS – Tuesday, August 11; 3:30-6:00pm

LEARN TO CROCHET – Tuesday, July 14; 3:30am-6:00pm

Derek has an easy way to teach crochet by breaking everything down into the basic stitches. CROCHET TECHNIQUE SERIES – 3 sessions *NEW*

Each month we'll work with 2 new stitches on a project. You'll practice in class and get the project started and then you can finish at home. Some of the techniques/projects that we'll tackle this series are Corner-2-Corner crochet, Graph-gans, Granny Squares and Join as You Go. We recommend you take our "Learn to Crochet" classes so that you better understand pattern symbols for technique-based projects. *Pattern/Book purchase required through TQS.* (You must know the basic skills for crochet)

BEGINNING TUNISIAN CROCHET – Saturday, September 19; 1:30-4:30 *NEW*

We're excited to offer this hands-on, guided introduction to Tunisian crochet, a technique that blends elements from crochet and knitting to create a unique textured project that you will start in class. This technique dates to the early 1800s and is currently becoming the most popular technique in crochet. You may want to consider taking our Learn to Crochet class for this class so that the references in the differences between standard and Tunisian crochet will make sense. *Book purchase required through TQS.* (All Levels)

KNITTING: BEYOND THE BASICS – Saturday, September 5; 3:00-5:30pm *NEW*

You want to push your envelope and move beyond the basics! You'll learn how to fix stitches in more comprehensive ways and really understand the structure of your stitches. With the help of hands-on exercises to review the basics and then sample some advanced tips and trips. We will use the techniques of Mosaic knitting to slip stitches in unique 2-color designs with one color per row (no floats or difficult scenarios). Make a new best friend! Harper is the perfect zip top tote for a craft (like knitting or crochet), beach time, a day on the go, or for a quick getaway. In class, you'll learn and use skills in the use of stabilizers for shape and body, installing zippers with tidy ends and straight-line quilting. *Pattern purchase required through TQS.* (Confident Beginner with sewing skills)

WARDROBE BY ME PAINTERS JACKET *NEW*

Make an oversized, unstructured UNISEX jacket with big patch pockets, dropped shoulders and a large convertible collar. The fit is generous and the simple design is a quick and easy project. We have some new denim and canvas weight fabric for you to work with. *There are 3 sessions with your enrollment, the first being a virtual session with Derek and the 2 scheduled in-person classes. Recommended for Very Confident Beginners with good sewing skills and capable of cutting your own fabric to Intermediate - Advanced levels. Please note: most students may not finish the project in class, but you will get instruction to finish at home. Pattern purchase required through TQS.*

CRISSCROSS APRON – Saturday, August 1; 10:30am-1:30pm *NEW*

Your new favorite reversible Apron pattern, with personality. This apron is so versatile and very wearable. *Pattern purchase required through TQS.* (All Levels but you must know how to cut with a rotary cutter and sew on your machine).

UPCYCLED JEANS TOTE – Friday, August 14; 3:00-5:30pm

Bring a pair, or two, of your own jeans, chinos or other similar pants to make a fun unique tote bag! We'll harvest material from your jeans to sew together a unique tote bag using pockets, belt loops and any stitched designs as potential parts of your bag. This is a fun, creative class and your tote will not look like the photo as everyone is inspired by the jeans from which they harvest. Basic beginner skills and rotary cutting skills are required (Confident Beginner)

This charming wall-hanging currently hanging in Kathye's office has some different applique techniques. Your wall-hanging ends up looking like a stained-glass window. *Book purchase is required through TQS.* (Intermediate)

Sundays – September 6, 20, 27 **1:00-3:00pm**
This beautiful quilt looks wonderful in any color combination. Uses just 6 fabrics for the entire quilt. The pattern includes paper templates to complete the project. *Pattern and specialty ruler purchase required through TQS. You must know how to rotary cut this class. Please note that students will not finish this project in class, but you will get instructions on finishing the project at home.* (Intermediate)
