After piecing your quilt, hand quilting is such a beautiful and peaceful finish to your beloved quilt top. We'll introduce you to the products to use, techniques and stitches, how to mark and the actual process of hand guilting your guilt top. You will be making a small project to practice these techniques. The project, designed by Stephanie, is Trapunto, a decorative quilted design in high relief worked through at least 2 layers of cloth by outlining the design in running stitch and padding it from the underside. (All Levels)

This 38" small wall hanging features all of the BeColourful techniques. Whereas this quilt is classified as a Beginner project, we do require taking our Beginning Paper Piecing class before enrolling in this class. In the first class, we will start making the paper pieced sections of the quilt and in the second class, we will put everything together for the quilt. Paper pieced items include spikes, stars and flying geese. Other techniques include, second seam allowances, inset circle sewing, easing fabrics and freezer paper techniques. Pattern purchase required and Fabric Kit available for purchase. (VERY Confident/Intermediate)
