BEGINNING SEWING (3 sessions)

\$65/series Eva/Kim/Kathy

Get to know your machine. We work with you to use and understand the operation of your machine. You'll sew 3 different projects giving you a basic overview of the main reasons people use their machine; basic sewing, zippers, buttonholes, etc. This class is a pre-requisite to Beginning Quilting if you do not already know how to sew. (Beginner)

Ever wonder how those beautiful tiny precise points are created? It might have been with paper piecing. We will walk you through the basics of paper piecing while you create part of a charming and easy project. (Beginner) **Kit Fee: \$10**

BEGINNING MACHINE APPLIQUE – Friday, March 31; 3:00-5:30pm**\$49** Kathy

Create beautiful applique designs using your sewing machine. You'll learn to use stabilizers/fusibles, layer your design pieces and set up your machine for different stitches (stitch choices are different on each machine). (Confident Beginner) **Pattern Fee: \$10**

WARDROBE BY ME TROPICAL CAMP SHIRT **NEW****\$75** DerekSaturdays, January 31 and February 7; 10:30am-2:30pm

Make a tropical camp shirt for yourself or for anyone in your life! Intermediate sewing skills recommended, this is a good first garment to sew. Using a fun cotton fabric of your choice, you'll want to make many more of this shirt once you get the pattern down. *There are 3 sessions with your enrollment, the first being a virtual session with Derek and the 2 scheduled in-person classes. There is a lot of prep work for the in-person classes and you are expected to be ready for class. Pattern purchase required.*

TUMBLING BLOCKS – Friday, February 20; 1:00-5:30pm**\$49** Kathy

This is a classic all-time favorite, and our pattern eliminates the dreaded Y-seam. Using strip piecing and color value placement, you'll achieve a quilt with a unique optical illusion when you flip it upside down. Pattern Purchase required through TQS. (Confident Beginner)

HEMINGWAY POUCH – Saturday, February 21; 2:00-4:30pm**\$42** Derek

The Hemingway Pouch is a fun multi-sized pouch pattern which is a good beginning project for zipper-cautious sewists. It can be made in a size for pencils/sunglasses and very large for books, notebooks and iPads. Great gift for people in your life and once you start making them you'll make a LOT of them! Beginner with capable sewing/rotary cutting skills. *Pattern purchase required.*

SEWING ROOM COLLAGE – Saturday, March 7; 10:30am-4:30pm **NEW****\$75** Shirley

Need a break from traditional quilting? Looking for an enjoyable challenge? Join us for this fun class and learn the Laura Heine collage techniques for creating beautiful works of art. This class will be using the "Teeny Tiny Pattern – Pin Cushion, Dress Form and Sewing Machine pattern and you will choose one of them to do for the class. Each pattern finishes out to a 16"x20". You will not need your machine in class. *There is a lot of prep work that you will be required to do before class. Pattern purchase required through TQS. Basic beginner skills and rotary cutting skills are required (Confident Beginner)
