You will create several projects using techniques such as double piped edges, perfect bindings - including ways to create decorative bindings, using ribbons for embellishment, how to perfectly space decorative stitches, circular sewing with trims/beading, Sashiko quilting, appliqué, modern piecing and more. In addition, you will explore how to quilt using various notions, stitches and specialty feet. Includes several projects created with these techniques. We will provide the sewing machines and all the accessory feet you will use during the class. A trunk show will also be presented which will include modern quilting and embroidery.

 - Flattering and easy to wear, you have a lot of options for different looks. A V-neck, front & back yoked dress that you'll wear to every occasion.
