Supplies:

- Fabric (colors in parentheses are the colors used in the sample)
 - Scraps for centers (yellow)
 - 1/3 yard each of 2 petal colors (reds)
 - 1/3 yard leaves (green)
 - 1/2 yard background (white)
 - 1 yard accent (dark green)
 - 1/2 yard triangles and binding (green)
 - 1/8 yard Steam a Seam Fusible Web OR Bosal Stitch & Peel
 - Fusible Web is for raw edge appliqué
 - Stitch & Peel is for turned edge appliqué
 - Both methods will be demonstrated in class
- Thread for piecing to match fabrics
- Thread for appliqué to match centers
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot pedal
 - Need to have a stitch plate capable of a zig zag stitch
- Quarter inch foot for piecing (with or without a guide)
- Zig zag foot for machine appliqué
- Flower head pins
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- 10 Ziplock sandwich bags
- Optional: Small iron and ironing surface (there will be 2 classroom irons)

Supplies below will be available to borrow during class:

- AccuQuilt Go Cutter
- GO! Courtyard Die, #55198 (If you own this die, please bring it to class)
- Cutting Mats

AccuQuilt Club Prep Work

Courtyard Poinsettias Table Runner and Trivets

Press all fabrics and cut the following strips before class:

- ▶ Centers (Yellow)
 - ▶ 1 3" strip
 - → Sub cut into 9 3" squares
 - ▶ Label bag with "A"
- ▶ Petals (Red)
 - ▶ 2 5" strips of each color
 - ▶ Sub cut into 24 5" x 3 1/2" rectangles of each color
 - Label bag 1 with "B"
 - ▶ Label bag 2 with "C"
- ▶ Leaves (Green)
 - 2 5 1/2" strips
 - ▶ Sub cut into 24 5 1/2" x 3" rectangles
 - ▶ Label bag with "D"
- ▶ Background (White)
 - ▶ 2 8" strips
 - ▶ Sub cut into 24 8" x 3" rectangles
 - ▶ Label bag with "E"
- Accent (Dark Green)
 - ▶ 4 6" strips
 - ▶ Sub cut into 24 6" squares
 - ▶ Label bag with "F"

Bring all remaining fabric and bags to class.
