Safe and Accurate Rotary Cutting Supply List

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Accurate rotary cutting creates the fabric shapes that make precision piecing possible. Learn to use the rotary cutter safely and effectively. In class, cut fabric in a variety of shapes and sizes, learn basic rotary cutter math, how to use fabric efficiently as you cut, and how to square up a quilted top.

Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter with a sharp blade
- Cutting mat at least 18" x 24"
- Rotary cutting rulers:
 - Bring a ruler that is at least 24" long and 6" to 8 ½" wide. The ruler should have a
 45 degree angle line and a 60 degree angle line printed on the ruler.
 - o If you have a smaller ruler (6" to 14" long), bring that as well.
- Fabric: one yard
 - o If possible, press the fabric prior to class
 - This is a time that you can use a fabric that you don't particularly like! The fabric will be used to cut strips and pieces in various sizes and shapes and will not be used in an actual project.

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
