Supply list

Cut out, label and interface ALL pieces prior to coming to class!

Purchase the Ginger Sallie Tomato and all supplies listed in the pattern

If the Ginger pattern happens to be on back order and not available until the day of class, please ask Quilters Quest to contact me and I can text you the cutting instructions. It is essential that you come to class with everything cut and interfaced. It will make your day much easier and is considerate to the rest of the class.

Sewing machine in good working order

Zipper foot for your machine

Wonder clips

Chalk or removable marking pen

Seam ripper

Scissors

Thread/bobbin to match your fabric and cork

The following are available at Quilter's Quest and essential if you continue making bags

1/4" Basting tape double sided

Stiletto

Zipper Genie to attach zipper pull

Point and Press by OESD

Big Jig, or similar product. To level presser foot while sewing over thick seams.
