

# Quick Zip Case

**2 ½"W x 2 ½"H x 8 ½"L**

Mary Foral's Supply List

**Please do not select a one-way design in your fabric choices!**

Pattern- Quick Zip Case (byAnnie)

Main fabric-fat quarter

Lining fabric-fat quarter

Contrasting fabric-fat eighth

Soft and Stable-11" x 13"

Handbag zipper 14" or longer (byAnnie zipper is recommended, see below\*\*\*)

Size 14 sewing machine needle, (topstitch is recommended)

¼" foot for sewing machine

Zipper foot

Walking foot (recommended but not required)

Thread to compliment your fabric and zipper

Marking tool (such as chalk marker for dark fabrics, water soluble for light fabrics)

Stiletto-byAnnie

Wonder clips

Pins

Seam Ripper

Scissors

Cutting mat

Rotary cutter

## Quilting ruler

\*\*\*A handbag zipper is wider than a dressmaking zipper and much easier to sew on to this bag. If you get a handbag zipper 28" or longer with two zipper pulls, you can use it for two bags. You can use one for this bag and the other for a future bag. Mary can show you how easy it is to divide this zipper to make two zippers.

NOTE: We will be cutting fabric and lining into an 11" x 13" rectangle as well as cutting some smaller pieces. A smaller cutting mat and ruler will work with this project. There is also one cutting station with rulers that can be shared among students if you don't have a cutting mat/ruler.
