Please quilt Set A1, A2, B, C1 and C2, then cut out all the pieces and label them BEFORE class. Can make either size.

SUPPLIES NEEDED	Large 13½" H x 16½" W x 6½" D	Extra-Large 16" H x 22½" W x 8½" D
Main fabric (body, pockets)	1½ yards	1¾ yards
Lining fabric (body, pockets)	1½ yards	1¾ yards
Coordinating fabric (zipper strips, inner pocket, inner divider, stabilizer sleeve, handles, bindings)	1½ yards	2½ yards
Sturdy fabric, such as vinyl, canvas, or cork (base)	10" x 25"	12" x 33"
ByAnnie's Soft and Stable®* (stabilizer for tote, 58" wide)	1 yard SS1036/SS2036	1½ yards SS1072/SS2072
Fusible interfacing* SUP179	¾ yard	1 yard
Handbag zipper* ZIP24, ZIP30, ZIP40, ZIPYD For the large [extra-large] tote you will need a minimum of 37" (46") of zipper tape and 2 (2) pulls to make: Zipper closure: 24" (30") Outer combo pocket: 13" (16")	Two 24" single-slide zippers	One 24" single-slide zipper and One 30" double-slide zipper
1½" polypro strapping* SUP164-1.5	3 yards	3¼ yards
Base stabilizer* (acrylic stabilizer)	6" x 14¾" BS120	7¾" x 20½" BS180

Sewing machine with ¼" foot and walking foot (preferable but not required)

Machine needle-topstitch size 14 works best

Thread to compliment fabrics and zipper (I like Aurifil)

Scissors

Pins

Wonder Clips

Removable markers such as Clover chalk pens or water soluble pen

Quilting ruler 6" x 24" or similar

Rotary cutter
