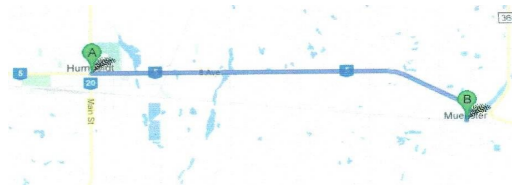

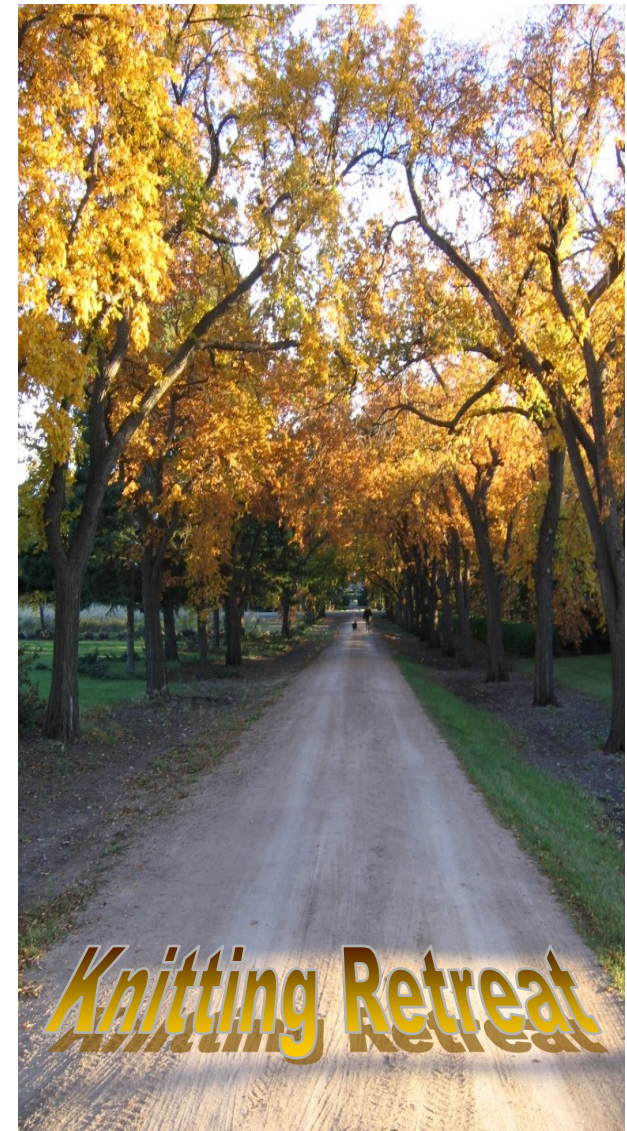


Driving instructions from Humboldt to St. Peter's Abbey.

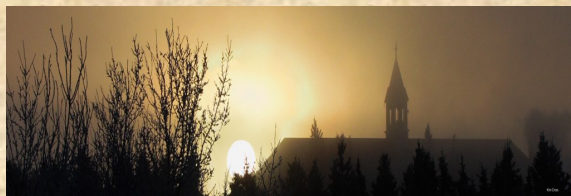
