Serger Academy: Pillowcase

About this Class

Decorative pillowcases make amazing gifts for children and adults alike. We'll begin by creating an oversized pillow case which will be completed on our serger. Then we will discuss ways in which you can make a second pillow case that may have embellishments such as piping, ruffles with either a rolled hem or wave stitch hem. Bring fabric for another as many get two done.

Supplies

Class Description

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Materials Needed for a standard pillow:

- 1 yard main fabric per pillowcase if using contrast for cuff or ruffle
- Traditional cuff: ½ yard for the cuff version
- Ruffle: ½ yard for ruffle
- Note: It is a good idea to prewash all fabrics for pillowcases, so use a 4-thread overlock on both cut ends and then wash the fabric. I always iron it using Magic Sizing or Best Press when it comes out of the dryer to make it a little crisper for sewing.

Optional Materials for Piping:

- 1 ½ yards cording for piping (3-5 mm)
- Width of fabric (40"-42") by 2" strip for piping

Equipment:

- Serger with regular foot, power cord, knife table and cover stitch table if your machine has that capability.
- Manuals and quick reference guides
- Ruffling foot for pillowcase with ruffle
- Piping foot for optional piping
- Chain/Cover Stitch foot for optional decorative stitching for 8 thread sergers
- Matching serger thread
- Ruffled cuff: 2 spools Wooly Nylon for rolled hem OR 2 spools of different colors for Wave stitch
- Chalk marker that will show on your fabric
- Clips or pins
- Double eyed needle or another tool to bury thread tails
- Scissors
