### Wave, Chain & Cover Stitch Guide Supply List

#### **About this Class**

This class is a basic class that will begin to teach you about the amazing features on your serger. A variety of different stitches will be covered during this class.

#### **Supplies**

- 8-thread serger with power cord and foot pedal
- Accessories that came with your serger listed in your manual
- Serger Instruction & Reference Manual
- Quick Reference Threading chart
- Scissors
- Two cones of wooly nylon or similar thread, two different colors, but not black
- Two spools of 40 wt. embroidery thread, again, not black
- Four cones regular serger thread, not black
- Tool for burying threads like a double eye needle

#### **We will be working on the following in this class:**

1. Threading your serger for overlock and rolled hem stitches
  - a. Lower and upper loopers
  - b. Needles for overlock, rolled hem
2. Identifying the parts to make various stitches and cutting features
3. Serging samples for you to keep in your serger notebook for easy reference using various types of fabrics
  - a. 4 thread overlock
  - b. 3 thread overlock – wide and narrow
  - c. 3 thread narrow hem
  - d. Rolled hem with and without wooly nylon in the looper(s)

#### **What we will be learning:**

- Wave Stitch in its 3 forms – used for decorative purposes
- Chain Stitch – Functional chain stitching and decorate possibilities
- Cover Stitch – Functional and decorative possibilities:
  - Triple cover stitch
  - Wide 2-thread cover stitch
  - 2 Narrow 2-thread cover stitch choices

*We'll learn what each looks like and when it's best to use each.*
