

Belle Kaleidoscope Table Runner using the Belle Kaleidoscope Quilt Pattern



White – Light A fabric: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard fabric

Pink – Dark B and C fabric: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard fabric

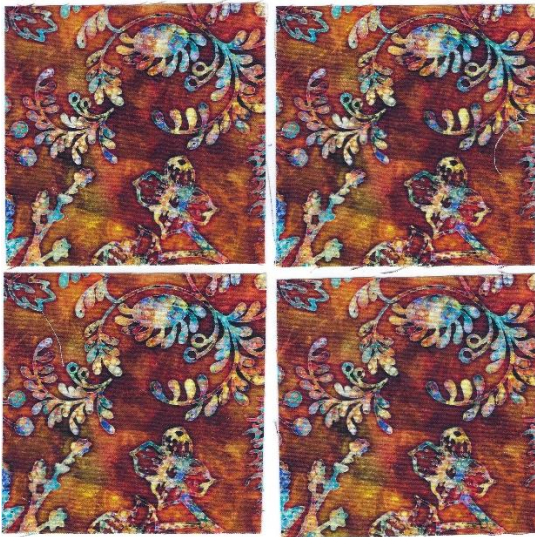
Corner triangles and setting triangles: $\frac{1}{3}$ yard fabric

Fabric for the kaleidoscopes:

There are 7 blocks of kaleidoscopes. Each block is made up of 4 – $3\frac{1}{2}$ ” squares of the same pattern. How much fabric you need depends on the repeat of the designs on the fabric you choose.

Example A shows one set of 4 – $3\frac{1}{2}$ ” squares of the same pattern. Example B shows how by turning each $3\frac{1}{2}$ ” square you will get a kaleidoscope.
