(This quilt can easily be resized to make it a custom fit.)

Please purchase before class <i>feel free to purchase in the shop as you will get a 15% discount on all supplies</i>	Basic sewing and quilting supplies:	Start Quilting" book by Alex Anderson Sewing scissors/Sheers Rotary cutter (45mm or 60 mm) 6"x24" rotary ruler Marking tool – wash away or iron away Sewing pins Seam Ripper Sewing machine needles – size 80/12 Sewing thread – neutral gray or beige <u>FABRIC REQUIREMENTS</u> (See page 41 in book) 1 yard Focus Fabric 7—8 1/3 yard pieces to coordinate with focus fabric 2/3 yard light neutral (can be 1/3 yard each of 2 light neutrals) 2/3 yard dark/medium neutral (can be 1/3 yard each of 2 dark neutrals) ¼ yard inner border 3/8 yard binding 1 ¼ yards backing Piecing thread (neutral color) Quilting thread (coordinating color) Batting 42" square or larger ¼" foot is very helpful
