Class Description	<p>Grow a summer garden of Black-eyed Susans on this adorable quilt. Pattern is from Fig Tree &amp; Co. There are two versions – each have the same flower blocks, but different sashings.</p> <p>Black Eyed Susan version is 57 1/2" x 77 1/2"</p> <p>Rudbeckia version is 62 1/2" x 82 1/2"</p> <p>Our sample in the store is the Rudbeckia Version. We used one color fabric for the background. You will need 4 yards for a single color background.</p>
Skill Level	Confident beginner with good rotary cutting skills
Supply List	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Black Eyed Susan Pattern</li> <li>2. Fabrics according to the pattern</li> <li>3. Sewing Machine with 1/4" or HP foot and plate – don't forget your power cord and acrylic table if you have one.</li> <li>4. Thread and bobbin to coordinate with fabrics</li> <li>5. Scissors, pins, etc.</li> <li>6. Rotary cutter and ruler for trimming</li> </ol> <p>We will send a cutting guide by mid May for a single color background like our sample.</p>
Additional instructions	Come to class with all fabrics cut and ready to stitch
	<p>Class #1 – Stitch the flower top sections Homework: Finish the flower tops before next class – 16 needed</p> <p>Class #2 – Stitch the leaf sections and assemble the block Homework: Finish the leaf and assembly of the blocks – 16 needed</p> <p>Class #3 – Make the sashings – Homework: finish the sashings</p> <p>Class #4 – Assemble the quilt top</p>
