

Connections (Pattern on back of the Pint Size Wedge Star instructions) - Supply List

The sample is made using the instructions for a 6-inch finished Wedge Star block. The addition of 2 borders (1-inch and 3-inch) creates a runner that is 14-inches x 32-inches. You can make this smaller or bigger by changing the size of your Wedge Star blocks or the sizes of your borders.

The supply list below is for the size of the sample which is described above.

Studio 180 Wedge Star or Pint Size Wedge Star tool

Fabric requirements

- ✓ ¼ yard of Color 1 (this is for diamond strips and inner border)
- ✓ 2/3-yard of Color 2 (this is for diamond strips, outer border and binding)
- ✓ ¼ yard of background fabric
- ✓ 1/8-yard of accent fabric

Additional Supplies

Sewing machine in good working order with new needle, power cord and foot control.

Scissors for trimming and snipping threads

Thread for piecing

Rotary cutter with good blade

Pins

6" x 24" and/or 6" x 12" ruler(s)

WHAT MUST BE DONE PRIOR TO CLASS

Cut your strips only – additional cutting will be done in class

From Color 1

- 1 strip 1 ¾ inch strip x wof
- 3 strips 1 ½ inch x wof (inner border)

From Color 2

- 1 strip 1 ¾ inch x wof
- 3 strips 3 ½ inch x wof (outer border)
- 3 strips 2 ¼ or 2 ½ inch x wof (binding)

From Background

- 2 strips 2 ¾ inch x wof
- 1 strip 3 inch x wof

From the accent fabric

- 1 strip 2 ¾ inch x wof
