

# Pumpkin Patch Supply List – Carpentersville

**This class is 2 sessions.** The **first session** you will need your embroidery machine, and we will stitch at least one each of Pumpkin Block, Square in a Square Block and Border Block. ***Precut your fabric, battilizer and optional wool batting before class.*** We will also learn block trimming. **Homework** will be to complete the blocks for the quilt. The **second session** you will need your sewing machine. We will finish trimming. We will assemble the blocks and talk about adding the quilt back.

## Supplies

- Download design from Sewing Concepts. Unzip it and put it on a USB before coming to class.

- 5 yards of Battilizer
- Wool batting (OPTIONAL)
- Required fabrics for the size you are making
- Embroidery threads to match background, border and pumpkin fabrics, pumpkin vine thread
- Vanish Lite Water-Soluble Thread
- Embroidery bobbin thread
- Piecing thread
- Appropriate hoop for your machine and the size you will be making

## Hoop sizes for Janome machines

### **For 5-inch blocks**

CM17: RE46d, ASQ27d or RE20d

15000: RE18, Sq23 or ASQ22

550E: RE20b, RE28b or RE36b

S9: Q14a or RE20a

### **For 8-inch blocks**

CM17: RE46d or ASQ27d

15000: SQ23 or ASQ22

550E: RE36b

S9: N/A

## Additional Supplies

Your machine in good working order with new needle, power cord and foot control.

Scissors for trimming and snipping threads

Embroidery scissors for trimming

Pinking shears – we have some to borrow in class and some for sale

Trimmer by George 2 or 3

Thread for piecing

60 mm rotary cutter with good blade

Pins
