# **Pumpkin Patch Supply List – Carpentersville**

This class is 2 sessions. The first session you will need your <u>embroidery machine</u>, and we will stitch at least one each of Pumpkin Block, Square in a Square Block and Border Block. *Precut your fabric*, battilizer and optional wool batting before class. We will also learn block trimming. Homework will be to complete the blocks for the quilt. The second session you will need your <u>sewing machine</u>. We will finish trimming. We will assemble the blocks and talk about adding the quilt back.

## **Supplies**

- Download design from Sewing Concepts. Unzip it and put it on a USB before coming to class.

- Wool batting (OPTIONAL)

- Embroidery threads to match background, border and pumpkin fabrics, pumpkin vine thread
- Vanish Lite Water-Soluble Thread
- Embroidery bobbin thread
- Piecing thread
- Appropriate hoop for your machine and the size you will be making

CM17: RE46d, ASQ27d or RE20d 15000: RE18, Sq23 or ASQ22 550E: RE20b, RE28b or RE36b

S9: Q14a or RE20a For 8-inch blocks

CM17: RE46d or ASQ27d 15000: SQ23 or ASQ22

550E: RE36b S9: N/A
