CLASS DESCRIPTION	Stitch your very own custom quilted Sneakers. Choose your own fabrics for the main part of the shoe, the tongue, and even the lining. These shoes can be made with any sewing machine, or even an embroidery machine. Customize them with whatever fabrics you'd like. Mine have the HoopSisters Logo, which is optional. Sewing Concepts will order the Shoe Kit for you in your size. The Shoe kit consists of the rubber sole, available in white, black, or tan. It also has the shoe insole, the color of the insole may not be like mine, and can not be chosen. The shoe pattern is included. FYI, no instructions come with the pattern, but you've got us! Sneaker kit is \$69.99.

Please purchase before class	Fabrics for sneakers One package HOOPShape	½ yard for outside of shoe, ½ yard for lining. This is a very generous estimate.
Bring to class	Class One: - All your fabrics for the sneakers - Sewing Machine with walking foot, OR, Embroidery machine and related items. - Thread to do the quilting, plus matching sewing thread. - Quilting ruler to mark your quilting lines - Fabric marker that will show up on your own fabric - Scissors, pins, etc. to use in class Class One: We will do all the quilting or Embroidery for the top of the shoes in class one.	Class Two: Your quilted shoe pieces completed from last session Sneaker kit Waxed thread and Sewing Awl, OR two large needles. We will talk about this in the first class. We have some to share. NO SEWING MACHINE is needed for class two. Ann and I will share a couple nice tools to have for the assembly process. Class Two: We hope to get at least one shoe assembled. It's very easy, but it will take a little time, especially if it's your first time.
