What HOMEWORK is required BEFORE class		• Prepare 4 - 6 18" X 18" quilt sandwiches; <i>backing and batting should be an inch or so larger on all sides</i> • Pin, glue, or spray basted • Fabric should be solid or tone on tone • Make sure you know how to attach your walking foot

Please bring from home		• Sewing machine in good working order • Walking foot/Even feed/Dual feed foot for your machine • Walking foot bar/guide • Quilt sandwiches • Coordinating thread - make sure there is a bit of contrast with your fabric - and a few full bobbins ○ <i>40 weight thread can be nice, but your piecing thread is fine too</i> • Double needle - your choice of spacing • 6" X 24" ruler • Marking tool of your choice • Quilting gloves - optional • scissors/snips
