

Watch Chain – Studio 180 Pattern

Supplies

Watch Chain Pattern – by Studio 180 Design

Four Patch Square Up Tool

Fabric requirements

Refer to the pattern for this information (My sample quilt is a lap which measures 70" x 70")

Additional Supplies

Sewing machine in good working order with new needle, power cord and foot control.

Preferred piecing foot (standard or ¼ inch)

Scissors for trimming and snipping threads

Thread for piecing

Rotary cutter with good blade

Pins

6 x 24 and/or 6 x 12 ruler

WHAT MUST BE DONE PRIOR TO CLASS

Refer to page one of the pattern for cutting instructions.

Cut the following:

- Dark
- Background
- Medium Strips (See note in the pattern-your strips must be at least 42 ½ inches)

NOTE: If you are using a jelly roll(s), you need to sub cut your strips. If you ARE NOT using a Jelly Roll(s), you will need to make sure you have cut the number of strips needed for the size quilt you are making AND sub cut the strips.

You don't need to cut your inner border, outer border, or binding before class, as we won't reach that part of the quilt.

Save the rest for class!
