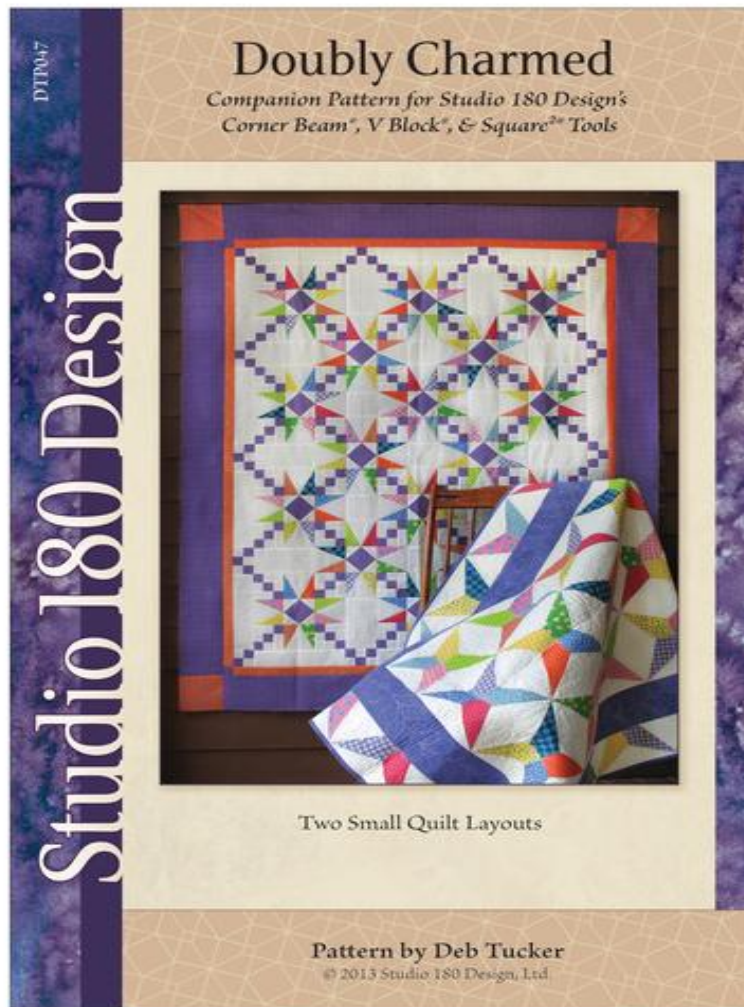


Charmed “V” Block – 47” by 59” finished

- Supply List: Pattern: **Doubly Charmed by Studio 180 Designs**
- Rulers: **Studio 180 “V” Block & “Square 2” OR Large Square Squared Tool**
- Fabric: For “V” Blocks side triangles – 3/4 yard same fabric **OR**
100 pairs of side triangles to be cut from various 5 1/2 inch squares for scrappy version for lots of variety – so at least 50 5 1/2 inch squares cut from scraps – you know you have them
- Background - 2 yards
- First Border – 1/2 Yard
- Second Border & chain Squares (includes binding – 1 3/4 yards
- Backing: 3 1/8 yards
- Supplies: Cutting rulers (6 X 24 or 6 X 12), scissors, rotary cutter with new blade, pins, thread to match project or blend, machine & quarter inch foot

Let’s have fun with the Tucker “V” Block and Square 2 tools

This lap size quilt can be made in two color ways – your choice.

Traditional or Scrappy A sample of each is available in Woodstock.

For the scrappy version, strips of your favorite fabrics will result in a rainbow of “V” blocks along with your chosen background. Then add complimentary colors for the chain squares and borders. How fun is that?

For the “traditional” version, chose a new fabric along with complimentary fabrics for the chain squares, borders and background.

You’ll master the “V” block & Square 2 Tools in no time.
