

Continuous Quilting Designs MBX

- ◇ Pick the ASQ22 Hoop, OK.
- ◇ Artwork, Insert Artwork, Find Heart Meander, Open.



***NOTE: the start spot on the left side & the end spot on the right side. They are both at the same spot. That way where you end the 1st one you will start the 2nd one & they will line up so this could be a continuous quilting pattern. ***


- ◇ On the left Tool bar, Digitize, Digitize Open Shape. In the Object Properties Box Make sure Single run Line is selected. On the Colors Bar choose a color that will show up against the clip art you are tracing.
- ◇ Start clicking on the picture following the lines until you get all the lines traced. Hit Enter when done. Left Clicks are straight Lines & right Clicks are curved lines.
- ◇ Select the design, In the Object Properties box, Stitch Settings, Length .100.

*** NOTE: Because we are using this as a quilting design, it is 2 layers of cotton & 1 layer of batting, you need to lengthen the stitch length so it looks like a normal stitch length. ***


- ◇ Select the design, Click on the reshape button. This is where you can adjust the nodes you made. Hover over 1 of the nodes, you will see a plus sign with arrows going in 4 directions, left click& drag to where you want it.

***NOTE: Notice the red + and the Green square. The green square is where the design starts. The red + is where the design ends. ***

- ◇ File, Save Design as, Name it Heart Meander. This is an EMB file. Make sure you know where you are saving it.
- ◇ File, Export Design, Heart Meander. Save it to the computer & stick if you are going to embroider it out.
- ◇ File, Print Preview, Print Now Button. Tape the 2 pages together using the registration marks. Cut off the overlap up to the registration marks on 1page if they bother you.
