Studio 180 Tumbling Triangle Pattern

Studio 180 Design V-Block Ruler

Invisigrip or True Grips for back of tools

6" X 12" and/or 6" by 24" Ruler

Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)

Fabric Precut for class (see below)

Sewing Machine, thread & bobbins, needles

General sewing supplies – scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.

Store Sample is 40" by 40" finished – fabric supply list is for this size completed.

Dark Fabric: 1 and 3/8 yards Light Fabric: 1 and 3/4 yards

Backing: 2 and 2/3 yards Binding: 1/2 yard

Pre-Class Cutting Instructions – cut in the order noted for best use of the fabric

40" by 40" finished quilt Blocks will be 3" finished

Dark & Light Fabric – cut in this order for each fabric

1. Two (2) strips at 3 1/2 inches by 46 inches – cut down length of fabric for borders

2. Two (2) 10 inch squares and one (1) 5 ¼ inch square for corners & setting triangles

Dark Fabric: Five (5) 4 inch strips from remaining Width of Fabric (WOF)

Light Fabric: Six (6) 4 inch strips from remaining Width of Fabric (WOF)

Bring all remaining fabric to class

NOTE: Additional sizes and fabric & cutting instructions provided on back of pattern. Cut in order provided above for best use of fabric - borders first, then squares, then remaining strips. All sizes will have the same number of blocks, in finished block size as identified on pattern.
