Cutting Instructions (All Versions):

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut one 40 1/2" x 20 1/2" rectangle centered on the design. (**Quilt Center**)

Fabric B:

- Cut five 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Use two strips to cut two 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips. Sew the remaining strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this

pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.

(2ND Border)

- Cut four 1 3/4" x WOF strips. (**Chain Block**)

Fabric C:

- Cut six 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Use four strips to cut forty-eight 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles. (**Chain Block**)
- Cut two 4 1/2" x WOF strips. (**Chain Block**)
- Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Use two strips to cut two 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" strips. Sew the remaining strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 2 1/2" x 58 1/2" strips.

(Outer Border)

- Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. (**Binding**)
- Cut one 6" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 6" squares. (**Corner Block**)

Fabric D:

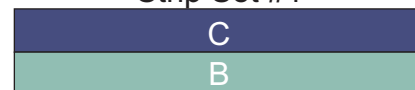
- Cut five 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Use two strips to cut two 1 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips. Sew the remaining strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips. (**1ST Border**)
- Cut one 6" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 6" squares. (**Corner Block**)

Piecing Instructions (All Versions):

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

- Sew one 1 3/4" x WOF **Fabric C** strip to the top of one 1 3/4" x WOF **Fabric B** strip lengthwise to make one 3" x WOF Strip Set #1. (Diagram 1) Repeat to make a second Strip Set #1.

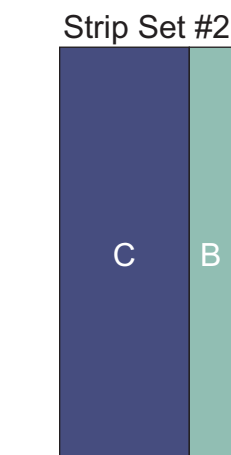
Make (2) = 3" x WOF unfinished

- From the two Strip Set #1's cut forty-eight 1 3/4" x 3" Unit 1 rectangles. (Diagram 2).

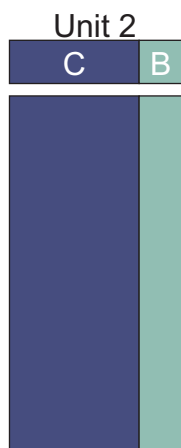


Make (48) = 1 3/4" x 3" unfinished

3. Sew one 4 1/4" x WOF **Fabric C** strip to the left side of one 1 3/4" x WOF **Fabric B** strip lengthwise to make one 5 1/2" x WOF Strip Set #2. (Diagram 3) Repeat to make a second Strip Set #2.
4. From the two Strip Set #2's cut forty-eight 1 3/4" x 5 1/2" Unit 2 rectangles. (Diagram 4).

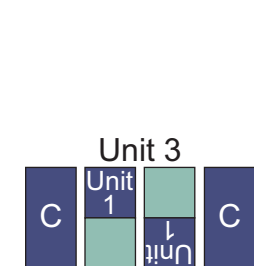

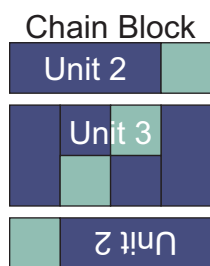


Make (48) = 1 3/4" x 5 1/2"

5. Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew together one 1 3/4" x 3" **Fabric C** rectangle, two Unit 1 rectangles and one 1 3/4" x 3" **Fabric C** rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make one 3" x 5 1/2" Unit 3 rectangle. (Diagram 5) Repeat to make an additional twenty-three Unit 3 rectangles.
6. Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew one Unit 2 rectangle to the top and bottom of one Unit 3 rectangle to make one Chain Block. (Diagram 6) Repeat to make an additional twenty-three Chain Blocks.

7. Place one 6" **Fabric C** square on top of one 6" **Fabric D** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 7) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 7) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line

(Diagram 8) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 5 1/2" to make two Corner Blocks. Repeat to make an additional two Corner Blocks. (Diagram 9)

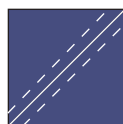
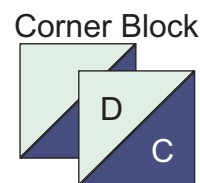

8. Paying attention to the block orientations, sew together four Chain Blocks to make the 5 1/2" x 20 1/2" Left Side Border. (Diagram 10) Repeat to make the Right Side Border. (Diagram 11)

9. Paying attention to the block orientations, sew together two Corner Blocks and eight Chain Blocks as shown to make the 5 1/2" x 50 1/2" Top Border. (Diagram 12) Repeat to make the Bottom Border. (Diagram 13)

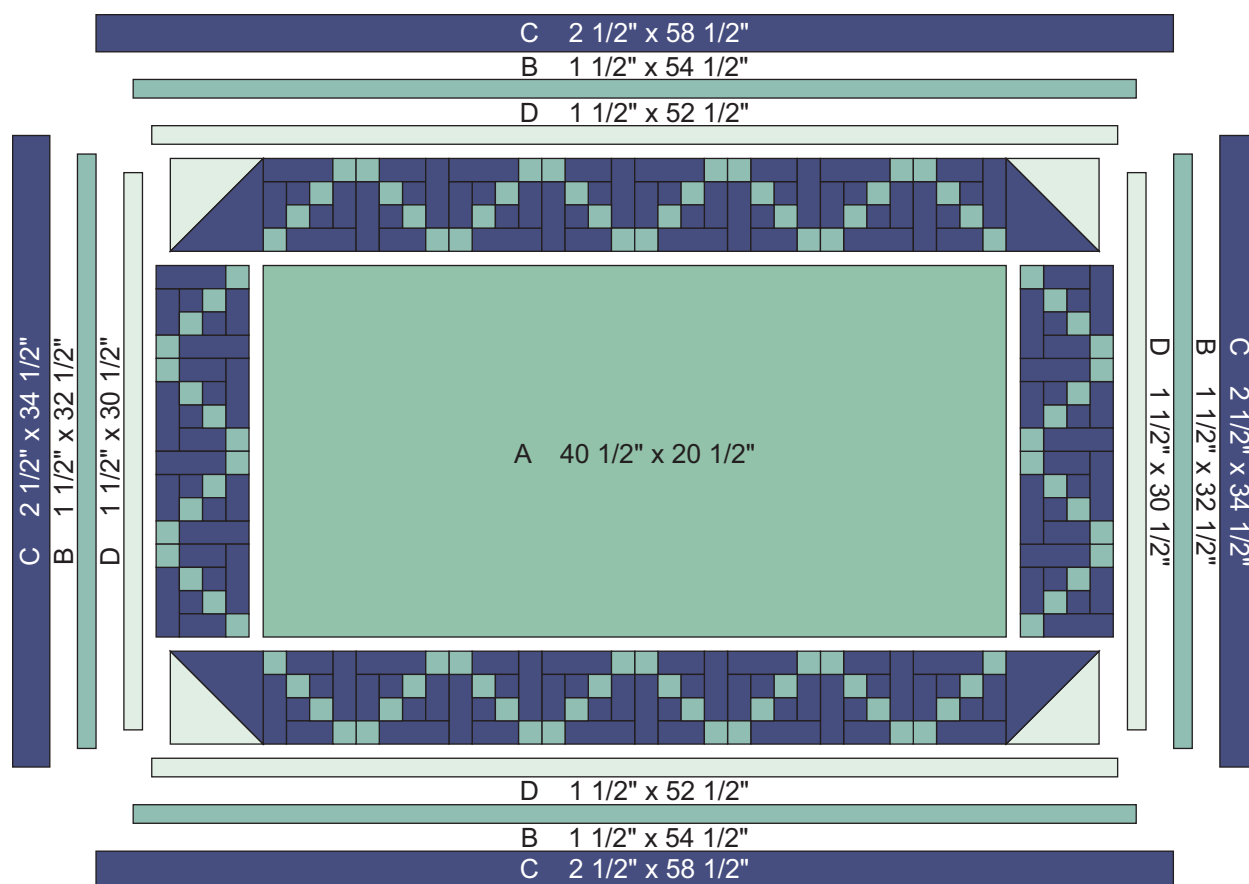

Quilt Assembly (All Versions):

10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the 40 1/2" x 20 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangle. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the **Fabric A** rectangle to make the Quilt Center.
11. Sew one 1 1/2" x 30 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
12. Sew one 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" **Fabric B** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" **Fabric B** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
13. Sew one 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 58 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing (All Versions):

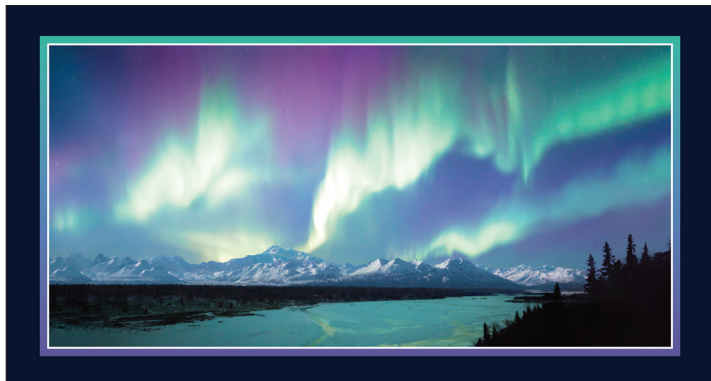
14. Prepare 42" backing using two widths of fabric. Press seams open. Trim to 66" x 46"; or use 108" backing and trim to 66" x 46".
15. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
16. Quilt as desired.
17. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
18. Attach 2 1/2" **Fabric C** binding strips using your favorite method.

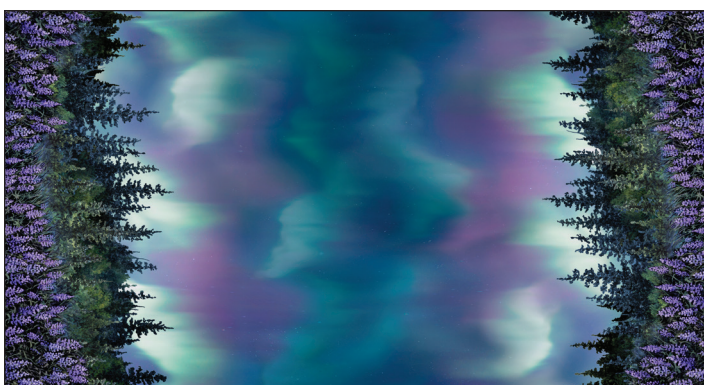

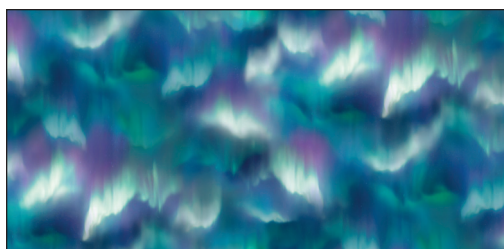

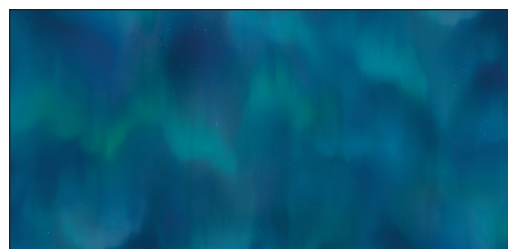
