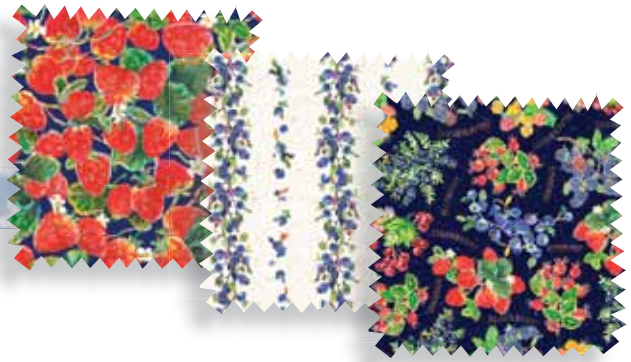

Skill level: Confident Beginner • Finished Placemat Size: approx. 12" x 18"

Placemat Yardages: (for 4 placemats)

Fabric A: JAMB 5052 N	1/2 yard
Fabric B: JAMB 5054 N	2/3 yard
Fabric C: JAMB 5058 N	1/2 yard
Fabric D: JAMB 5059 R	1/3 yard
Fabric E: JAMB 5059 Y	1/4 yard
Backing: JAMB 5053 N suggested	1 1/2 yards
Batting	four 18" x 24"

Cutting Instructions:

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE BEGINNING. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut one 13 1/2" strip; subcut four 7 1/2" x 13 1/2" rectangles.

From Fabric B:

1. Cut eight 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut six 2" strips; subcut eight 2" x 8 1/2" strips and eight 2" x 17 1/2" strips. (2nd Border)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut seven 1" strips; subcut eight 1" x 11 1/2" strips and eight 1" x 18 1/2" strips. (3rd Border)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut six 1" strips; subcut eight 1" x 7 1/2" strips and eight 1" x 14 1/2" strips. (1st Border)

Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew one 1" x 7 1/2" E strip to both ends of one 7 1/2" x 13 1/2" A rectangle; press. Sew one 1" x 14 1/2" E strip to the top and bottom of the rectangle; press.
2. Sew one 2" x 8 1/2" C strip to both ends of the rectangle; press. Sew one 2" x 17 1/2" C strip to the top and bottom of the rectangle; press.
3. Sew one 1" x 11 1/2" D strip to both ends of the rectangle; press. Sew one 1" x 18 1/2" D strip to the top and bottom of the rectangle; press.
4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to complete four placemat tops.

Finishing:

1. Cut four 18" x 24" rectangles from the backing fabric.
2. Layer placemat top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with placemat top squaring corners.
5. Join eight 2 1/2" B binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the placemat.

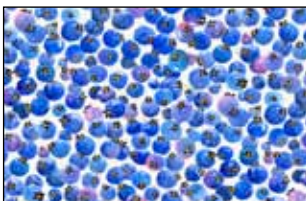
