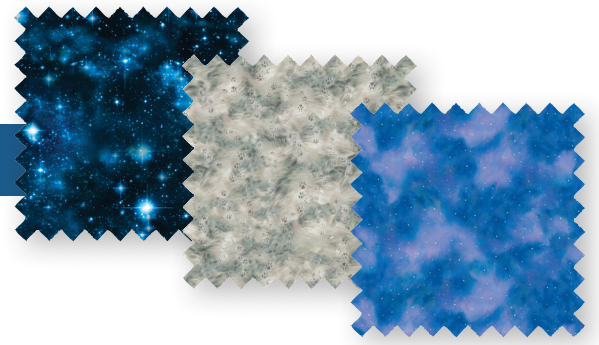

Fabric A	SOTM-6165-PA	1 panel
Fabric B	SOTM-6166-DB	7/8 yard
Fabric C	SOTM-6167-SGR	1/2 yard
Fabric D	SOTM-6169-LB	1/4 yard
Fabric E	SUED-300-N	1 1/8 yards
Fabric F	SUE7-303-EW	1/8 yard
Backing	SOTM-6166-DB	3 1/2 yards
Batting	58" x 64"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Cut one 34 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle centered on the design. (**Quilt Center**)

Fabric B:

- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Use Template D to cut forty-eight pieces. (**Star Block**)
- Cut one 2 3/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut twelve 2 3/8" squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make twenty-four half-square triangles (HST). (**Star Block**)
- Cut three 6 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 6 1/2" squares, two pieces using Template A, and two 6 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips. (**Moon Blocks & 2ND Border**)

Fabric C:

- Cut two 6 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 6 1/2" squares. Sew the remaining strips together end to end with a diagonal seam. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut one 6 1/2" x 48 1/2" strip. (**2ND Border**)

Fabric D:

- Cut one 5" x WOF strip; sub-cut two pieces using Template B. (**Moon Blocks**)

Fabric E:

- Cut four 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips. (**1ST Border**)

- Cut six 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips. (**3RD Border**)
- Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips. (**Binding**)
- Cut two 3 3/4" x WOF strips. Cut twenty-four pieces using Template E. (**Star Blocks**)

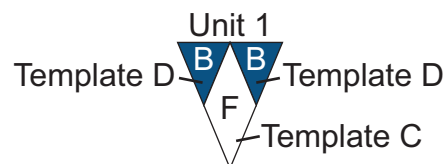
Fabric F:

- Cut two 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Cut twenty-four pieces using Template C. (**Star Blocks**)

Piecing Instructions:

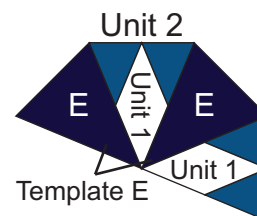
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components. For the most accurate piecing, match seam points when adding each piece. A seam point is where two or more seams intersect.

1. Sew one **Fabric B - Template D** piece to both sides of one **Fabric F - Template C** piece. Press seams open to make one Unit 1 piece. (Diagram 1) Repeat to make an additional twenty-three Unit 1 pieces.

2. Sew together two **Fabric E - Template E** pieces alternating with two Unit 1 pieces. Press seams open to make one Unit 2 piece. (Diagram 2) Repeat to make an additional eleven Unit 2 pieces.

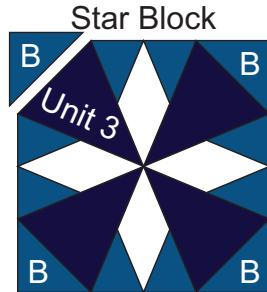

- Sew together two Unit 2 pieces along their long sides to make one Unit 3 piece. (Diagram 3)
Repeat to make an additional five Unit 3 pieces.
- Sew one $2\frac{3}{8}$ " **Fabric B** triangle to each corner of one Unit 3 piece to make one Star Block. (Diagram 4) Press seams open and trim to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make an additional five Star Blocks.

- Find and mark the center of the curve on the **Fabric D - Template B** piece and the **Fabric B - Template A** piece. Align the two pieces right sides together, matching the center mark on each piece. Pin the two pieces together at the center mark, then at each end. Continue to pin as needed. Carefully sew the two pieces together using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. (Diagram 5) Flip open the sewn unit and press to make one Moon Block. (Diagram 6) The block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make a second Moon Block.

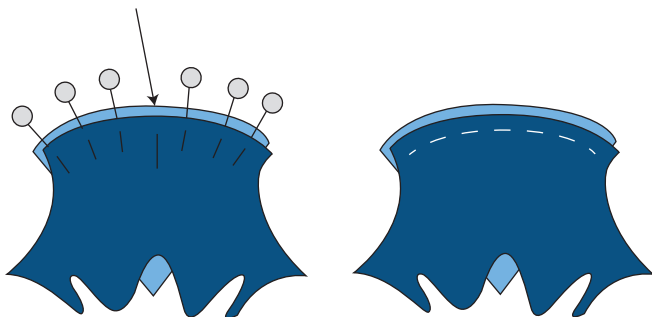
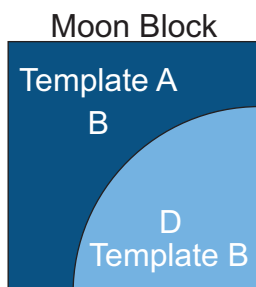

Make (2) = $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished

- Place one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric C** square on the bottom of one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** strip, right sides together. (Diagram 7) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 7) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam to make one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 strip. (Diagram 8)

- Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagram 9 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make one Unit 5 strip.

8. Sew one Star Block to the top of the Unit 4 strip to make the 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" Left Side Border. (Diagram 10)
9. Sew one Star Block to the top of the Unit 5 strip to make the 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" Right Side Border. (Diagram 11)

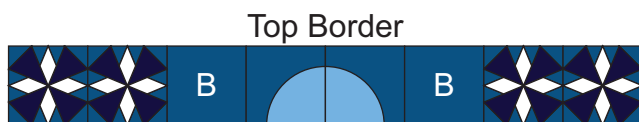

10. Sew together two Star Blocks, one 6 1/2" **Fabric B** square, two Moon Blocks, one 6 1/2" **Fabric B** square and two Star Blocks, in that order from left to right, to make the 6 1/2" x 48 1/2" Top Border. (Diagram 12)



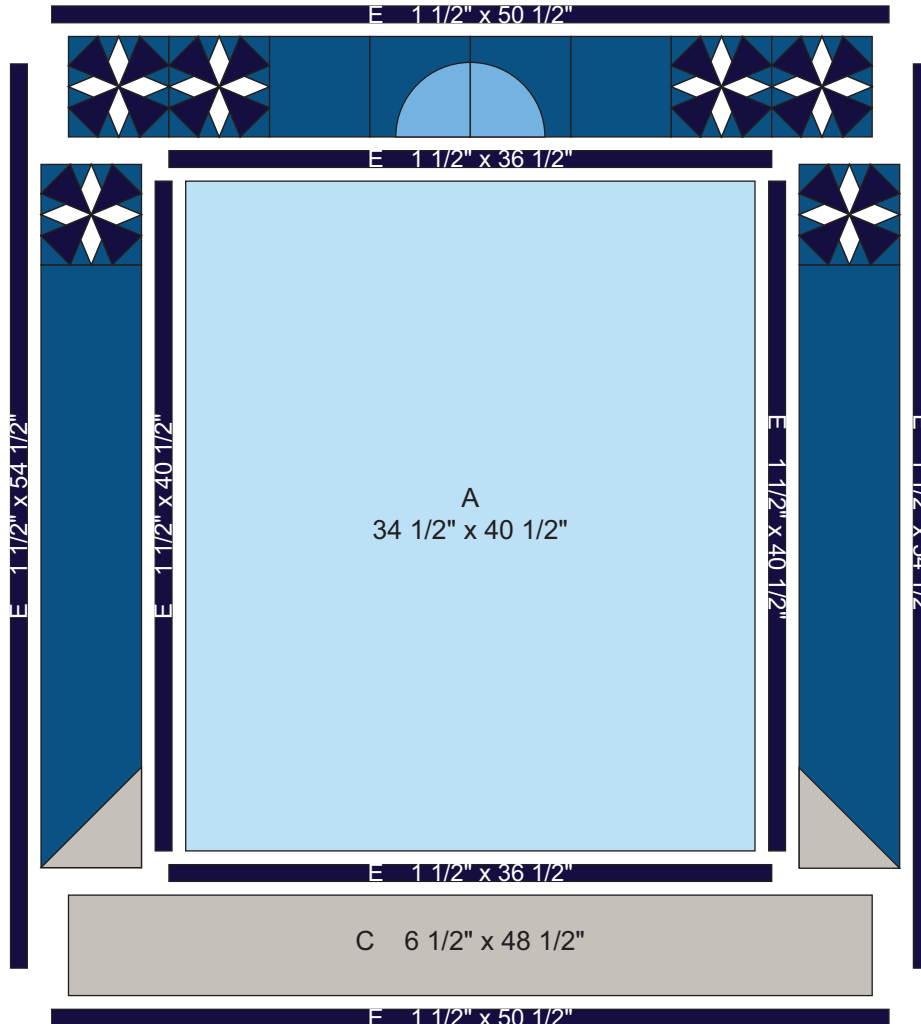

Quilt Assembly:

11. Sew one 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to each side of the 34 1/2" x 40 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangle. Sew one 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the top and bottom of the **Fabric A** rectangle to make the 36 1/2" x 42 1/2" Quilt Center.
12. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center.
13. Sew the Top Border to the top of the Quilt Center.
14. Sew the 6 1/82" x 48 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
15. Sew one 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

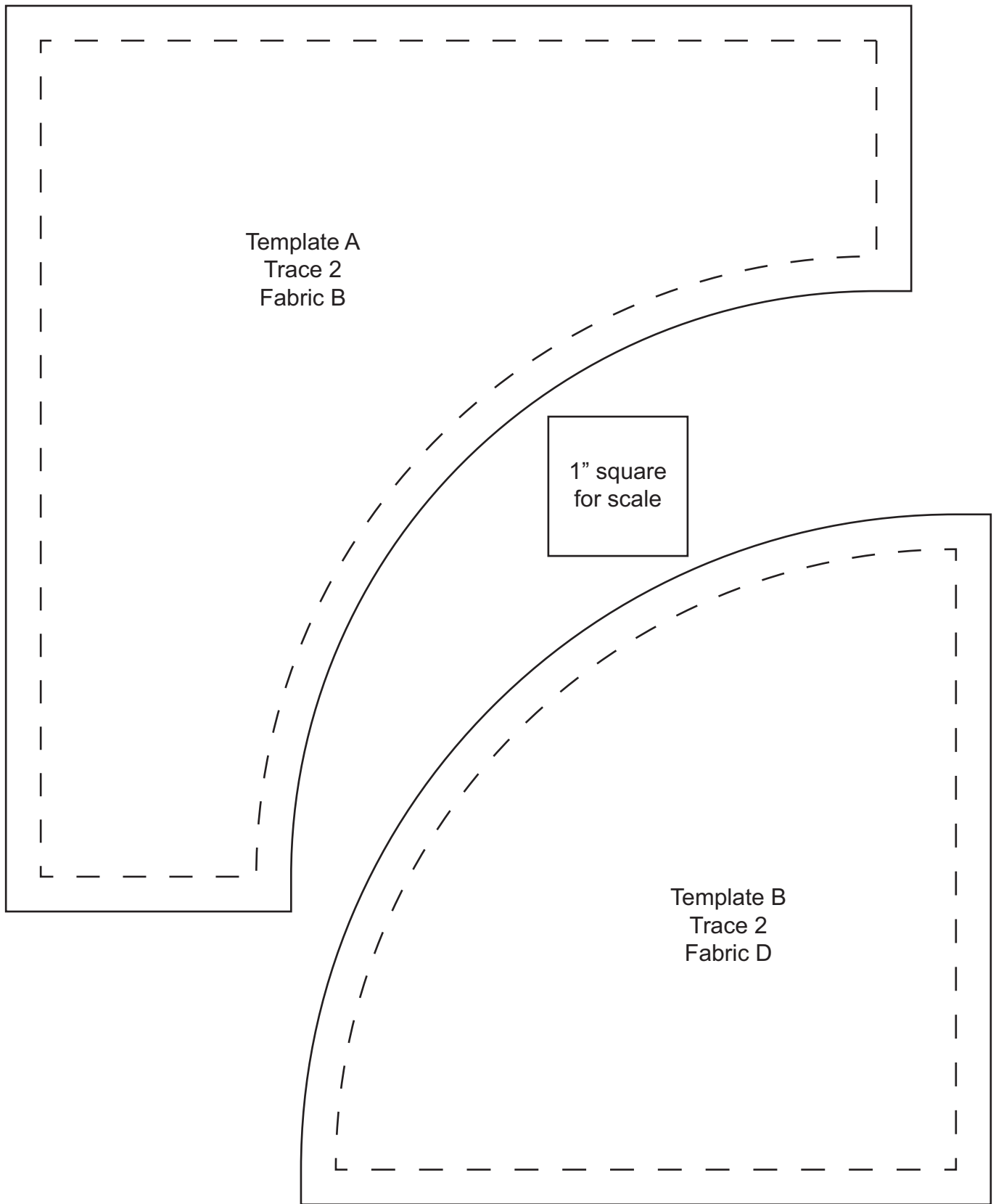
Finishing:

16. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim to 58" x 64".
17. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
18. Quilt as desired.
19. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
20. Attach 2 1/2" **Fabric E** binding strips using your favorite method.

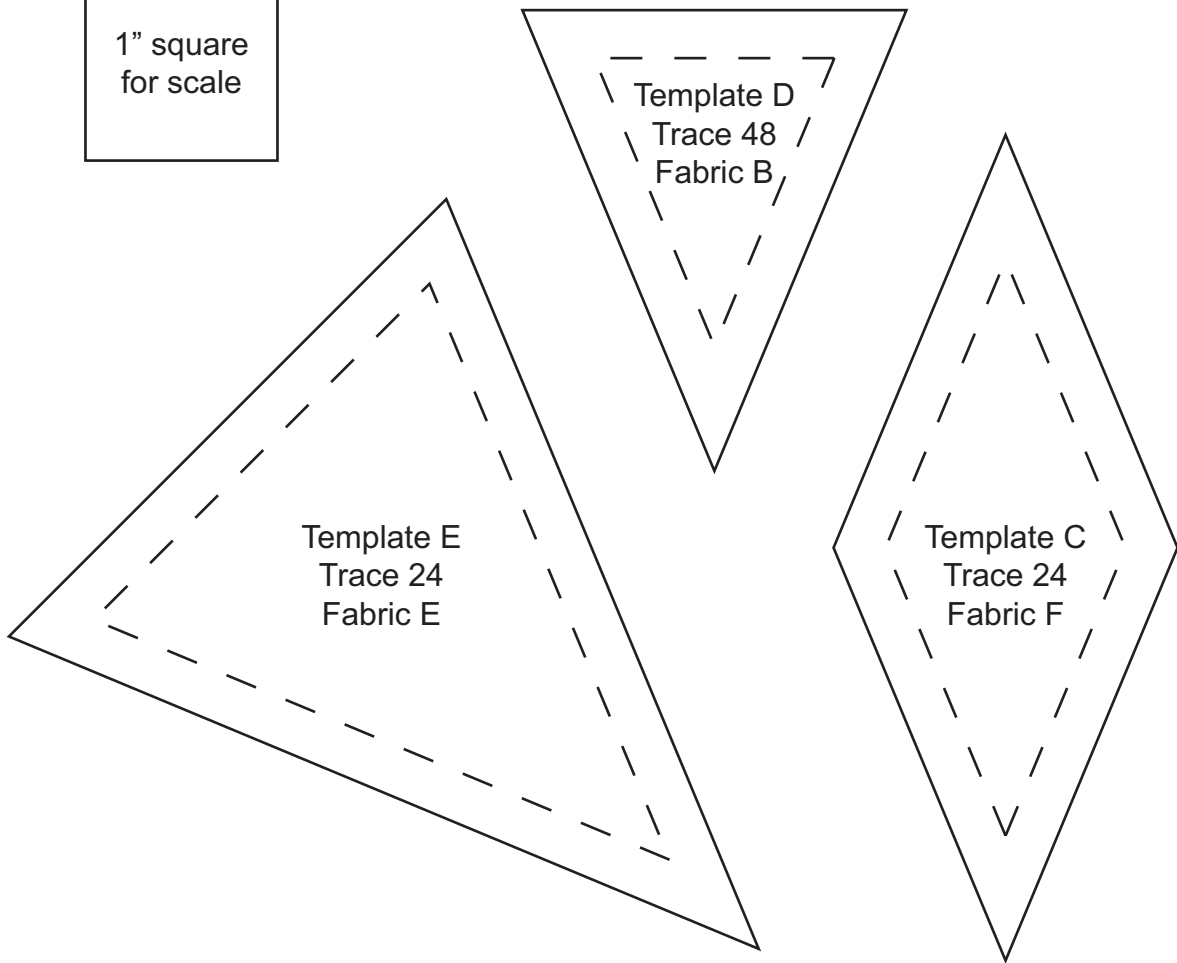
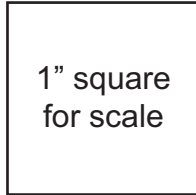


Quilt Diagram

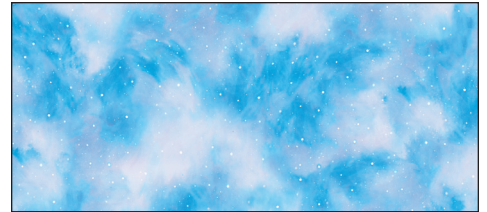

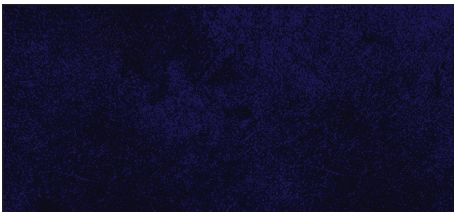
