Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut one 23 1/2" x 31 1/2" rectangle centered on the panel. **(Center Block)**

Fabric B:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 7/8" squares. Cut each square across one diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner to make two 4 7/8" triangles **(Blocks)**

Fabric C:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 7/8" squares. Cut each square across one diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner to make two 4 7/8" triangles **(Blocks)**

Fabric D:

- Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together end to end and cut two 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips. **(Outer Border)**
- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips. **(Outer Border)**

Fabric E:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 4 7/8" square. Cut the square across one diagonal to make two 4 7/8" triangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut one 1 1/2" x 31 1/2" strip. **(Center Block)**
- Cut one 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" strip. **(Center Block)**
- Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. **(Binding)**

Fabric F:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 7/8" squares and four 2" squares. Cut each 4 7/8" square across one diagonal to make four 4 7/8" triangles. **(Blocks)**

Fabric G:

- Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut four 3 1/2" squares and two 2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric H:

- Cut one 6 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut one 6 1/2" square, two 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, two 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, two 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles, one 4 7/8" square and three 4 1/2" squares. Cut the 4 7/8" square across one diagonal to make two 4 7/8" triangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut three 3 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles, twenty 3 1/2" squares, sixteen 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. **(Blocks)**
- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and seven 2 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut twenty 2" squares. **(Blocks)**
- Cut three 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces and fifty 1 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric I:

- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric J:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 7/8" squares and one 4 1/2" square. Cut the 4 7/8" squares across one diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner to make four 4 7/8" triangles. *NOTE: Only the two bottom triangles will be used.* **(Blocks)**

Fabric K:

- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut twelve 2 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric L:

- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric M:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 7/8" squares and two 2" squares. Cut the 4 7/8" squares across one diagonal to make four 4 7/8" triangles. **(Blocks)**

Fabric N:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 7/8" squares, one 4 1/2" square and two 2" squares. Cut the 4 7/8" squares across one diagonal to make four 4 7/8" triangles. **(Blocks)**

Fabric O:

- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut four 2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric P:

- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut four 2 1/2" squares. **(Blocks)**

Fabric Q:

- Cut one 4 7/8" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make four 4 7/8" triangles. **(Blocks)**

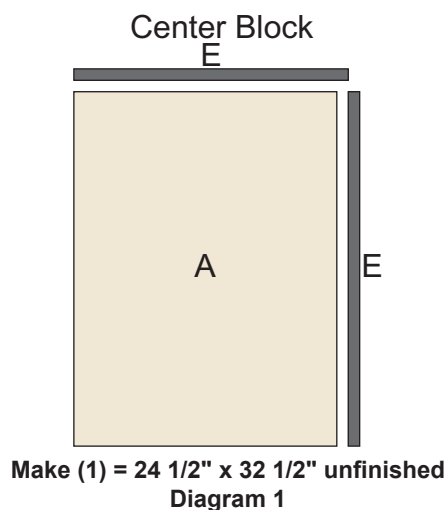
Fabric R:

- Cut one 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 2" squares. **(Blocks)**

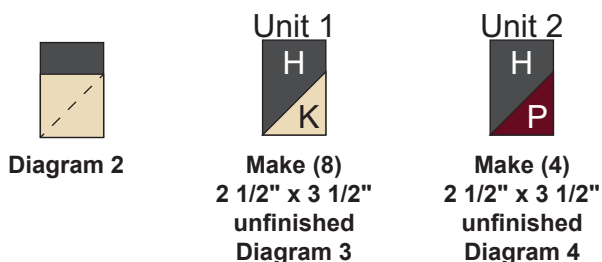
Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

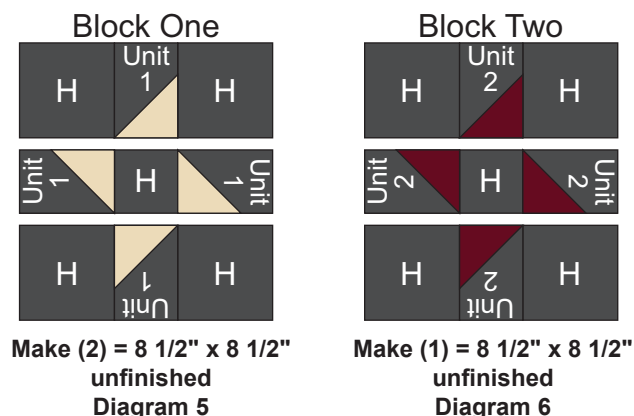
1. Sew one 1 1/2" x 31 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the right side of the 23 1/2" x 31 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangle. Sew one 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the top of the **Fabric A** rectangle to make the 24 1/2" x 32 1/2" Center Block. (Diagram 1)



2. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric K** square on the bottom of one 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 2) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one Unit 1 rectangle. (Diagram 3) Repeat to make an additional seven Unit 1 rectangles.
3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Diagram 4 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make four Unit 2 rectangles.



4. Sew one 3 1/2" **Fabric H** square to each side of one Unit 1 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 1 rectangle to each side of one 2 1/2" **Fabric H** square to make the middle row. Sew together the three rows lengthwise to make one 8 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 5) Repeat to make a second Block One square.
5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Diagram 6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make one Block Two square.



6. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric K** square on the top left corner of one 4 1/2" **Fabric H** square, right sides together. (Diagram 7) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 7) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle

1/4" away from the sewn seam. (Diagram 8)

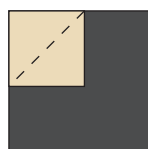

7. Follow Diagram 9 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" **Fabric K** square to each of the remaining corners of the 4 1/2" **Fabric H** square to make one 4 1/2" Unit 3 square. (Diagram 10)

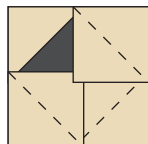
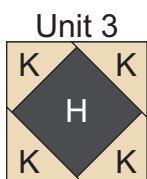

8. Place one 3 1/2" **Fabric H** square on top of one 3 1/2" **Fabric G** square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 11) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 11) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 12) to make two half-square triangles. (Diagram 13)

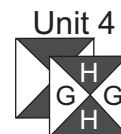
9. Place one half-square triangle from Step 8 on top of another half-square triangle, right sides together. Make sure the center seam is going in the same direction on both half-square triangles and the **Fabric H** triangle in the top block is opposite from the **Fabric H** in the bottom block. (Diagram 14)
10. Draw a diagonal line across the top half-square triangle so that it goes through the sewn seam. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line. (Diagram 15) Cut on the drawn line to make two Unit 4 squares. (Diagram 16) Trim each unit to measure 2 1/2" square.
11. Repeat Steps 8-10 to make an additional six Unit 4 squares.

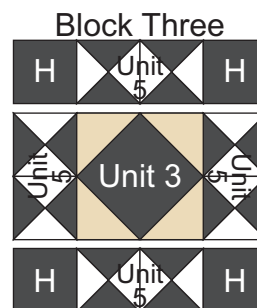

12. Sew together two Unit 4 squares to make one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 5 rectangle. (Diagram 17) Repeat to make an additional three Unit 5 rectangles.

13. Sew one 2 1/2" **Fabric H** square to each end of one Unit 5 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 5 rectangle to each side of the Unit 3 square to make the middle row. Sew together the three rows lengthwise to make one 8 1/2" Block Three square. (Diagram 18)

14. Place one 2" **Fabric F** square on top of one 2" **Fabric H** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 19) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 19) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 20) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 1 1/2" to make two Unit 6 squares. (Diagram 21) Repeat to make an additional six Unit 6 squares.

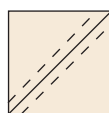

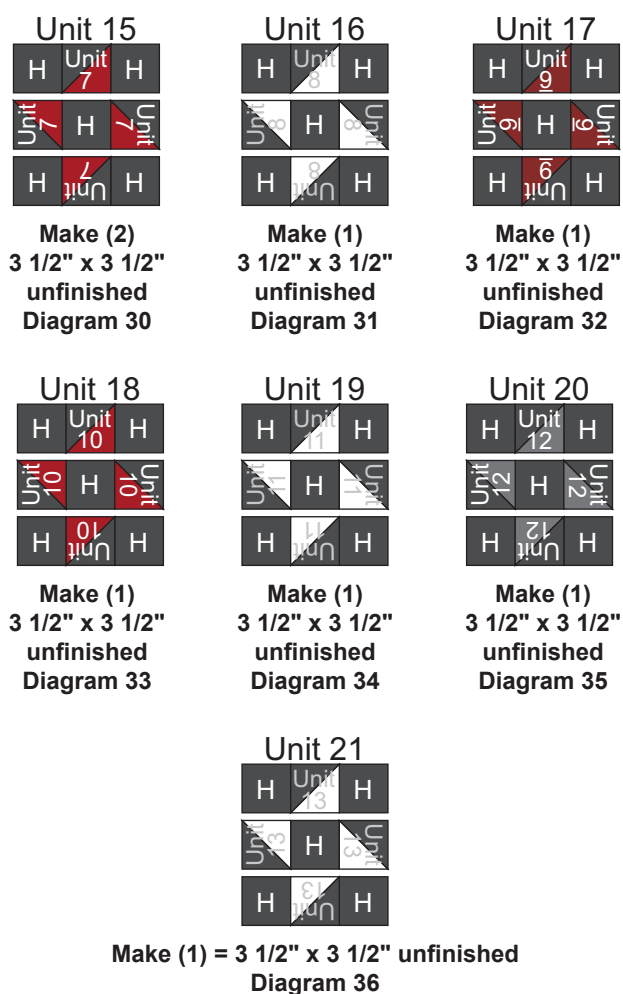
15. Repeat Step 14 and refer to Diagrams 22-28 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 7 through Unit 13.



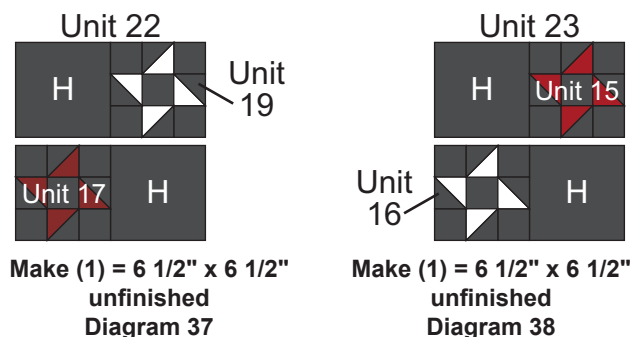
16. Sew one 1 1/2" **Fabric H** square to each side of one Unit 6 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 6 square to each side of one 1 1/2" **Fabric H** square to make the middle row. Sew together the three rows lengthwise to make one 3 1/2" Unit 14 square. (Diagram 29) Repeat to make a second Unit 14 square.



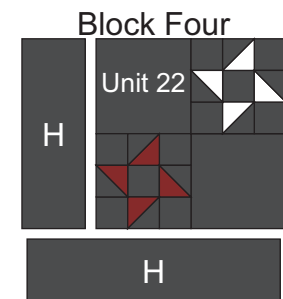
17. Repeat Step 16 and refer to Diagrams 30-36 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 15 through Unit 21.



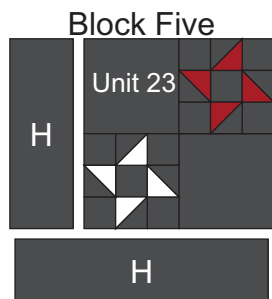
18. Sew one 3 1/2" **Fabric H** square to the left side of one Unit 19 square to make the top row. Sew one Unit 17 square to the left side of one 3 1/2" **Fabric H** square to make the bottom row. Sew together the two rows lengthwise to make one 6 1/2" Unit 22 square. (Diagram 37)
19. Sew one 3 1/2" **Fabric H** square to the left side of one Unit 15 square to make the top row. Sew one Unit 16 square to the left side of one 3 1/2" **Fabric H** square to make the bottom row. Sew together the two rows lengthwise to make one 6 1/2" Unit 23 square. (Diagram 38)



20. Sew one 2 1/2 x 6 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the left side of three Unit 22 square. Sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the bottom of the newly sewn rectangle to make one 8 1/2" Block Four square. (Diagram 39)
21. Sew one 2 1/2 x 6 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the left side of the Unit 23 square. Sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the bottom of the newly sewn rectangle to make one 8 1/2" Block Five square. (Diagram 40)

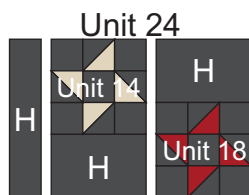

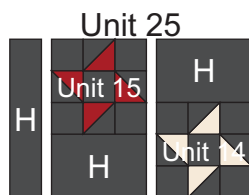

22. Sew one 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the top of one Unit 18 square to make the right column. Sew one Unit 14 square to the top of one 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to make the middle column. Sew together one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle, middle column and right column, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make one 7 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 24 rectangle. (Diagram 41)
23. Sew one 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the top of one Unit 14 square to make the right column. Sew one Unit 15 square to the top of one 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to make the middle column. Sew together one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle, middle column and right column, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make one 7 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 25 rectangle. (Diagram 42)

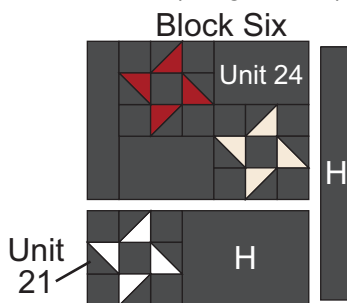

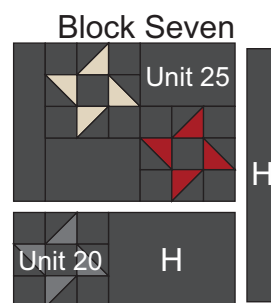

24. Sew one Unit 21 square to the left side of one 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the bottom of one Unit 24 rectangle. Sew one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the right side of the newly sewn rectangle to make one 8 1/2" Block Six square. (Diagram 43)
25. Sew one Unit 20 square to the left side of one 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle. Sew the newly sewn rectangle to the bottom of one Unit 25 rectangle. Sew one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the right side of the newly sewn rectangle to make one 8 1/2" Block Seven square. (Diagram 44)

26. Sew one 4 7/8" **Fabric J** triangle to one 4 7/8" **Fabric C** triangle along their long sides to make one Unit 26 square. (Diagram 45) Trim the unit to measure 4 1/2" square. Repeat to make a second Unit 26 square.

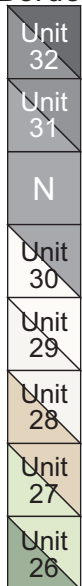

28. Sew together one Unit 32 square, one Unit 31 square, one 4 1/2" **Fabric N** square, one Unit 30 square, one Unit 29 square, one Unit 28 square, one Unit 27 square and one Unit 26 square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" Left Side Border. (Diagram 54)
29. Sew together the Block Six square, Block Two square, Block Four square and one Block One square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the 8 1/2" x 32 1/2" Right Side Border. (Diagram 55).

30. Sew one 4 1/2" **Fabric H** square to the top of one Unit 33 square. Sew the newly sewn

rectangle to the left side of the Block Five square. Sew one Block One square to the right side of the Block Five square. Sew one Block Seven square to the right side of the Block One square. Sew the Block Three square to the right side of the Block Seven square to make the 36 1/2" x 8 1/2" Top Border. (Diagram 56)

Sew together one 4 1/2" **Fabric J** square, one Unit 26 square, one Unit 27 square, one Unit 28 square, one Unit 29 square, one Unit 30 square, one Unit 31 square, one Unit 34 square and one 4 1/2" **Fabric H** square, in that order from left to right, to make the 4 1/2" x 36 1/2" Bottom Border. (Diagram 57)

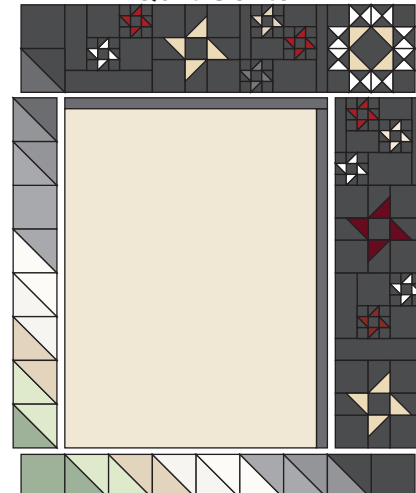

Quilt Assembly:

32. Sew the Right Side Border and Left Side Border to the sides of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the 36 1/2" x 44 1/2" Quilt Center. (Diagram 58)

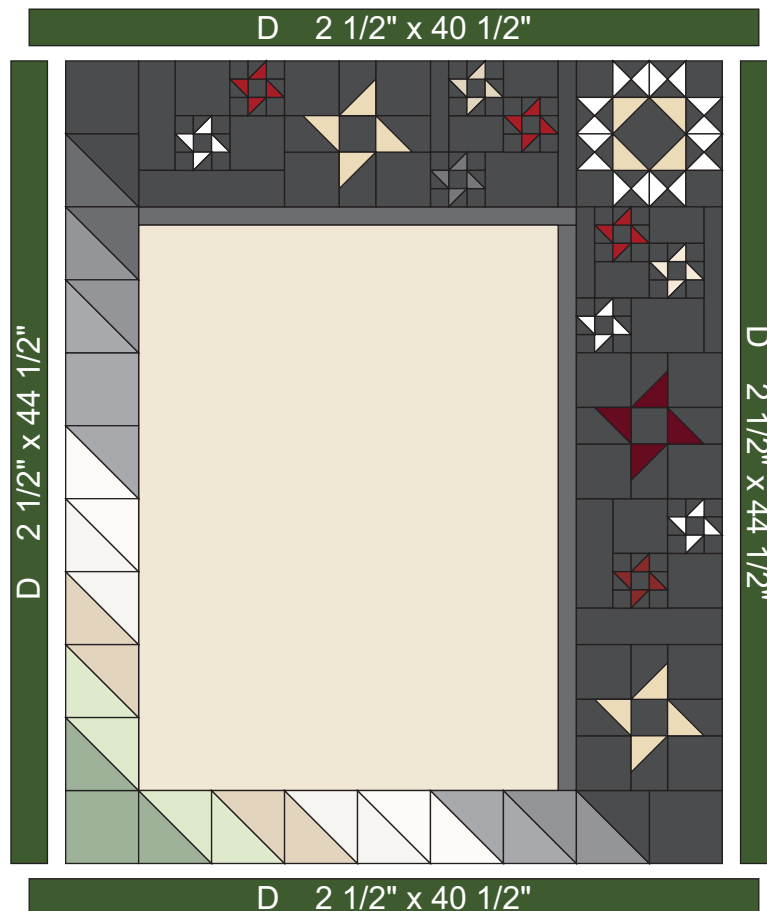

33. Sew one 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top.

Finishing:

34. Trim 108" backing fabric to 48" x 56".
35. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
36. Quilt as desired.
37. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
38. Attach 2 1/2" **Fabric E** binding strips using your favorite method.
