

Overlapped Monograms

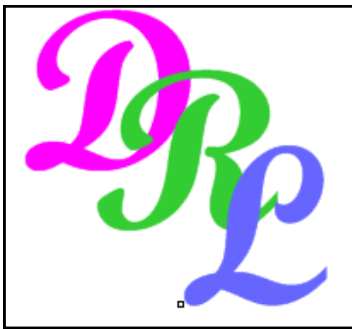


- Select *New*.
- Switch to *Artwork Canvas*.
- Select the *Vector Lettering* tool.
- Select the font you wish to use. Choose a font that is not overly thick. In the example, *Script MT Bold* was used.
- Type your first initial.
- Resize to 200 pts.
- Repeat to add two more initials. Be sure to click away from the first initial to add the second and third initials so they are ungrouped.
- Make each letter a different color by clicking on the desired color chip.

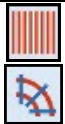
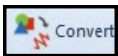
Overlapping the Letters



- Move the individual letters so they overlap.
- Right click on each letter and select *Convert to Curves*.
- Open *Object Manager*.
- Select the letter you want to do the trimming in *Object Manager*.
- Hold the *Ctrl* key down and select the letter you want trimmed.
- Select the *Trim* icon in the *Property bar*.
- Repeat for the second set of letters.



Converting to Embroidery



- Select *Ctrl + A*.
- Select *Convert Artwork to Embroidery*.
- Select each letter and click on *Satin Fill*.
- While the letter is selected, select *Add Stitch Angles* in the *Edit Toolbox*.
- Add stitch angles by adding two left clicks across the letter.
- Press *Enter* to activate the changes.
- Save the design as *Interwoven Monogram*.

Notes:

To select a letter, select the *Vector Lettering* icon and highlight across the letter by clicking within the black squares.
