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# Midnight Woods

## Yardages:

Fabric A: MIWO 4348 PA............................................ 1 panel
Fabric B: MIWO 4349 DB ......................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................................... $3 / 4$ yards
Fabric C: 56 "

## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut panel 20 1/2" x 42 1/2" keeping design centered.

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut five 2 1/2" strips. Cut two strips 2 1/2" x 40 1/2". Sew remaining three strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut eighteen 2 1/2" squares. (Blocks)
From Fabric D:
2. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut twenty-six 2 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

## From Fabric E:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip; subcut eight 2 1/2" squares. (Blocks)
2. Cut five 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut four $11 / 2$ " strips. Using two strips, cut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Use remaining strips to cut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. If you are unable to cut the length of these strips, sew remainders from cutting the shorter strips to these strips to extend. (Inner Border)

## From Fabric G:

1. Cut three 2 1/2" strips; subcut thirty-six 2 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

## From Fabric H :

1. Cut two 1 1/2" strips; subcut two 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips. (Panel Frame)
2. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut twenty 2 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

## From Fabric I:

1. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut eighteen 2 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

## Piecing Instructions:

(Refer to Block \& Quilt Diagrams)

1. Sew one 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" H strip to both sides of the panel. Press toward the strips.
2. Block 1: Sew five 2 1/2" H squares alternately with four 2 1/2" G squares to make one 9-patch block. Press seams in opposite directions from row to row. Sew rows together and press seams open or to one side. Repeat to make four blocks.
3. Block 2: Referring to Step 2, sew five 2 1/2" G squares alternately with four 2 1/2"I squares to make one 9-patch block. Repeat to make two blocks.
4. Block 3: Sew five 2 1/2" I squares alternately with four 2 1/2" C squares to make one 9-patch block. Repeat to make two blocks.
5. Block 4: Sew five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{C}$ squares alternately with four 2 1/2" D squares to make one 9-patch block. Repeat to make two blocks.
6. Block 5: Sew five $21 / 2$ " D squares alternately with four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} E$ squares to make one 9 -patch block. Repeat to make two blocks.
7. Block 6: Sew five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ G squares alternately with four 2 1/2" D squares to make one 9-patch block. Repeat to make two blocks.
8. To make one side block border, sew seven blocks together in this order: Block 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 1. Press seams open. Repeat to make second side border.
9. Sew one pieced border to each side of the center panel as shown in the Quilt Diagram. Press seam to the H strip.
10. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime} F$ strip to both sides of the quilt. Press toward the strips. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ F strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the strips.
11. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strip to both sides of the quilt. Press toward the strips. Sew one 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the strips.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths with a horizontal seams. Press seams open. Trim backing to 48 " $\times 56$ ".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.

4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} E$ binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
